From Our Parochial Administrator...



Christ the King and Its Culture of Reciprocity.

Halfway through our Lenten journey, we are encouraged by the “desert” experience of spiritually disciplining ourselves through prayer, fasting and almsgiving (Lk 4:1-13) and strengthened by the glimpse of God’s glory (Lk 9: 28b-36), to reach our destination in faith, hope and love.

Prayer, fasting and almsgiving are means and not end in themselves. Prayer opens us up to the love of God. By loving Him that we truly follow in his footsteps.

Along the way, we are faced with some decisions that have immense ramifications for our lives. We say no to other things, denying ourselves some wants and desires, for the greater good. Fasting is a conscious decision to exercise our willpower for the sake of Christ and the Gospel.

As with prayer and fasting, so with almsgiving. We can’t give what we don’t have. But it is not enough to give. It is not enough to love Jesus. We must be open to be loved by Jesus. Pope Francis once said that “it is easier to love because we can decide how to manifest that love. But it is more difficult to be loved, to receive love, because we are not in control and we cannot know in advance how the other would give love.”

His Holiness Pope Francis is encouraging us to develop a culture of encounter, of reciprocity. He calls our attention here in Christ the King Parish to the same reciprocity. “No one is so poor that he/she has nothing to give, and no one is so rich that he/she has nothing to receive” (Plenary Council of the Philippines II).

May God bless us all.
