Happy Easter!!!


Christ is risen! He suffered, died, rose from the dead and He comes to meet us.

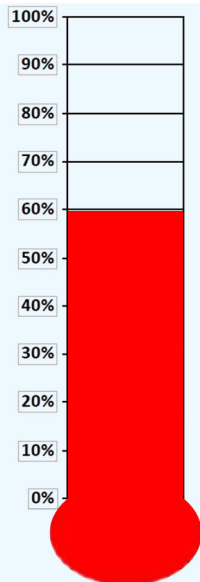

Charles Passe Scholarship for Post-High School Education

Charles Passe began his association with Christ the King Parish in 1981 after moving from Minnesota to Tucson, then to Mesa where he continued his love of woodworking.

Mr. Passe set up this endowment in 1994, and his commitment to young people and their success lives on through this endowed scholarship. Any Christ the King registered parishioner that is pursuing post-high school trade or vocational education (IT, automotive, dental, construction are a few examples) is eligible. The size of the award will be based on the number of qualified applicants.

The Charles Passe Scholarship Fund is managed by the Catholic Community Foundation for Christ the King Parish.


¡Cristo ha resucitado! Sufrió, murió, resucitó de la muerte y viene a encontrarse con nosotros.
