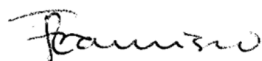
A GRATEFUL DISCIPLE

We recognize that Jesus has high expectations of his followers. In one parable, the Master hears that his steward is squandering his property. One way of prayerfully entering the parable is to imagine Jesus asking us about our stewardship. Imagine sitting with Jesus as he tells you the parable. You know he wants to teach you. His parable includes the Master saying to his student: "What is this I hear about you?" and then asking (you know Jesus means you!) for an account of his gratefulness. Like any disciple, we do not own the gift of faith that God has given us. But, it is our responsibility to ensure that it flourishes and gives the Master glory.

In the coming week, I will write to all parishioners about the program of being a Grateful Disciple. We are asking all parishioners to make a commitment to consider God first in sharing of gifts, prayer and service. I invite everyone to review the care and effort they are making in their lives of faith and commit to deepening their discipleship. What time do you spend in prayer through bible study, faith sharing groups or programs outside Mass, and what else can you do to take the next step? What talents do you have and use to serve people and the parish, and can you take another step? What treasure can you share? Can you share your financial resources, do you contribute to Christ the King Community and its ministries, and is there another step you should take?

The letter you will receive in the coming week will contain a commitment card to encourage you to reflect on God's blessings. Please enter the process of reflection and affirmation as we take this next step in our parish journey.

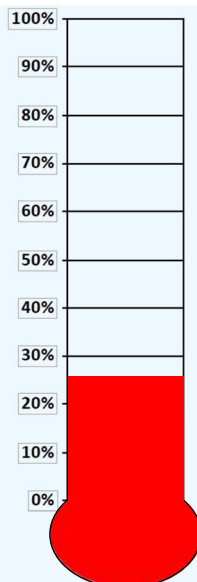
ABSTINENCE: Catholics (14+) must abstain from eating meat on Fridays during Lent. "Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs --- all of which live on land.

Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, consommé, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are technically not forbidden. However, moral theologians have traditionally taught that we should abstain from all animal-derived products (except foods such as gelatin, butter, cheese and eggs, which do not have any meat taste). Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish are permitted."

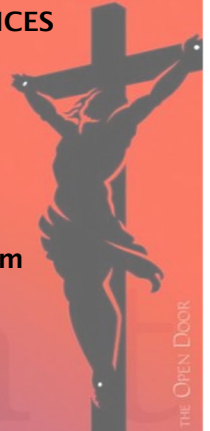

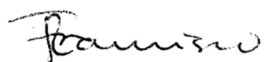
UN DISCÍPULO AGRADECIDO

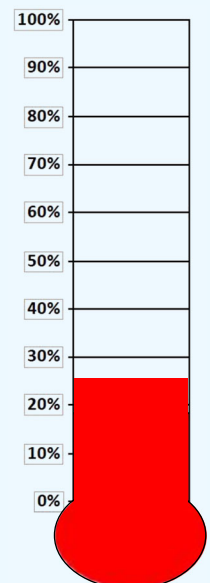

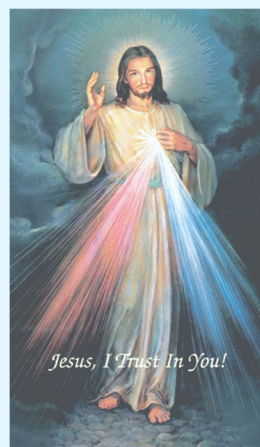

ABSTINENCIA: Católicos (14+) deben de abstenerse de comer carne todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma. Leyes de abstinencia consideran que la carne proviene sólo de animales como pollos, vacas, ovejas o cerdos --- todos los cuales viven en la tierra. Las aves también son considerados carne. La abstinencia no incluye jugos de la carne y alimentos líquidos a base de carne. Por lo tanto, los alimentos tales como el caldo de pollo, consomé, sopas cocinadas o con sabor a carne, salsas de carne o salsas, así como condimentos o condimentos a base de grasas animales no están técnicamente prohibidas. Sin embargo, los moralistas han enseñado tradicionalmente que debemos abstenernos de todos los productos derivados de animales (excepto los alimentos tales como gelatina, mantequilla, queso y huevos, que no tienen ningún sabor de la carne). Los peces son una categoría diferente de los animales. De sal y de agua dulce especies de peces, anfibios, reptiles, (animales de sangre fría) se permiten y mariscos.
