BROTHERS & SISTERS

"Those who have opened their hearts to God's love, heard his voice and received his light cannot keep this gift to themselves." (Pope Francis, Lumen Fidei)

The complexities of being a new mom, helping my son with special needs to achieve his goals before entering kindergarten, helping my eight year old to emerge himself in a spiritual preparation to receive Jesus in the Eucharist and confirm his Catholic faith this May, and still do all the daily responsibilities of a mom and wife can be at times tiresome. I know moms in the community might agree that this vocation of Motherhood is complex, but it has its fruits that we may or may not see. I would not be able to participate in many of my children's functions if it was not for others. As you might recall from my letter this past September, I come from a small community in Tempe: St. Margaret. We called each other Hermana or Hermano because working for God makes us a family. If it was not for all of you, **Sisters and Brothers** in Christ, I and many of us that lead a ministry here at Christ the King, we would not be able to continue with the mission we are given. We are collaborators of His vine for His greater glory.

It is in the work of ministry that we grow in faith and in love. "Faith is not simply an individual decision which takes place in the depths of the believer's heart...By its very nature, faith is open to the "We" of the Church; it always takes place within her communion." (Lumen Fidei, 40). Brothers and Sisters we are capable of many things with Christ.

I would like to thank you for being part of this community. Thank you for your talents and your time. Ministry work is always blessed but always in need of your help and prayers. I want to give you some updates from my office:

Facilities: At this moment I am working on scheduling all the events from the staff and in April, I will begin with all ministerial activities. We have so many opportunities to glorify God according to your spirituality and work ethic. I invite you to attend the Ministry Fair and bring others to God. Our community is changing and so are the needs. We would like to see your involvement in this way to gather and share what God is doing in your ministry and also to meet others that are new to the community. I will like to mention some events that are currently happening in the community.

Coffee & Donuts. We are in need of servers after the 7 am Mass on Sundays. Please contact the parish office if you would like this help in this ministry.

Marriage Preparation: If you or someone you know is interested in Marriage within the Catholic Church, send them to the Parish Office to sign-up for a session of information, hosted on a monthly basis (Spanish on Sundays and English on Saturdays). I ask for your prayers for the new couples that will be beginning their Marriage discernment.

Respeto a la Vida (New Ministry in Spanish): Throughout Lent, we will continue the 40 days for life campaign: we will be praying the Rosary at 3 pm in the Church on Sundays. Then, throughout the year we will begin campaigns to cultivate a community prayer life for Life. Prayer is essential and we need yours for this ministry. If you are interested in joining, contact me.

Vivir en Cristo: Formation and cultivating Strong Marriages through the study of scripture and the Catholic teachings in Spanish. Couples are welcome to attend! We could not gather without the help of **Rayito de Luz**, an Evangelization ministry for children three years of age and older. They are essential to the outcome and fruit of our ministry. Many parents are capable of attending knowing they are in care of our precious gifts. We are always happy to see new couples join us. We meet Fridays at 7:30 pm.




ABSTINENCE: Catholics (14+) must abstain from eating meat on Fridays during Lent. "Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs --- all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, consommé, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are technically not forbidden. However, moral theologians have traditionally taught that we should abstain from all animal-derived products (except foods such as gelatin, butter, cheese and eggs, which do not have any meat taste). Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish are permitted."

Te Invitamos a rezar el Rosario por la Vida todos los domingos a las 3pm en la Iglesia.



ABSTINENCIA: Católicos (14+) deben de abstenerse de comer carne todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma. Leyes de abstinencia consideran que la carne proviene sólo de animales como pollos, vacas, ovejas o cerdos --- todos los cuales viven en la tierra. Las aves también son considerados carne. La abstinencia no incluye jugos de la carne y alimentos líquidos a base de carne. Por lo tanto, los alimentos tales como el caldo de pollo, consomé, sopas cocinadas o con sabor a carne, salsas de carne o salsas, así como condimentos o condimentos a base de grasas animales no están técnicamente prohibidas. Sin embargo, los moralistas han enseñado tradicionalmente que debemos abstenernos de todos los productos derivados de animales (excepto los alimentos tales como gelatina, mantequilla, queso y huevos, que no tienen ningún sabor de la carne). Los peces son una categoría diferente de los animales. De sal y de agua dulce especies de peces, anfibios, reptiles, (animales de sangre fría) se permiten y mariscos.




