# Holy Week: A Story of God's Love


Today the Church invites us into the journey of the Holy Week. This is the part of our journey of faith where we reflect upon the painful sequence of events in the life of Jesus. It begins with His triumphal entry into Jerusalem that we commemorate today through the events of the Last Supper, His agony in the Garden of Gethsemane and betrayal to His crucifixion and death. They are sobering events, yet each of which must take place for God to glorify Jesus and to bring salvation to a world "mired in sin" (Psalm 40) through His resurrection.

Today, on Palm Sunday, we have the Passion narrative as our gospel reading. Unlike other Sundays, the gospel is proclaimed with your participation. This gives all of us, priest, deacon, and you, a role in Christ's passion. Note that we are the mob. Ironically, we assist in condemning Jesus while clutching palm branches. We start out acting like angels, singing "Hosanna." And we end up just being the mob, crying out "Crucify Him."

But no! We are not the worst people who ever lived, far from it. Yet for the journey of this Holy Week to have meaning, we must own our place within it. To be a part of the Body of Christ is to be with him on the cross. To be a member of the church is to both acknowledge our sinfulness and the potential for good within us.

We, the church, are not different from the gathering of people at the crucifixion. Jesus is present in our midst just as he was in the midst of two broken and sinful thieves, yet maintaining the potential for good within them at the very end. One of them tapped that potential through faith in Jesus and gave us words to live by: "Jesus, remember me."

Expectedly, he responded with GRATITUDE to Jesus. God expects us to be GRATEFUL for his love for us. He expects each of us to be a GRATEFUL DISCIPLE. With a grateful heart that is strong enough to translate our love of God into love of others.

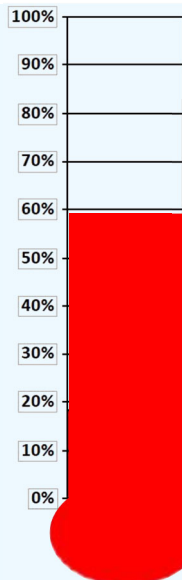

The corresponding line on your return tells your tax liability (the amount you owe the state for the year based on your income), which you can pay to Catholic Education Arizona up to the maximum tax credit limits (\$1,087/single or \$2,173/married filing jointly) without going over your tax liability. Then, receive a dollar-for-dollar state tax credit, which will help change a child's life forever!

### I understand that Catholics ages 18 to 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, but what exactly are the rules for these fasts?

A. Fasting on these days means we can have only one full, meatless meal. Some food can be taken at the other regular meal times if necessary, but combined they should be less than a full meal. Liquids are allowed at any time, but no solid food should be consumed between meals.

### Q. Are there exemptions other than for age from the requirement to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday?

A. Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting. animals) and shellfish are permitted."

## SEMANA SANTA: LA HISTORIA DE AMOR DE DIOS


Hoy la Iglesia nos invita al camino de Semana Santa. Este es la parte de la fe cuando reflexionamos sobre la secuencia dolorosa de eventos en la vida de Jesús. Inicia con Su entrada triunfante en Jerusalén que recordamos hoy a través de los eventos de La Última Cena, Su agonía en el Jardín de Getsemaní y su traición que lo llevó a la crucifixión y muerte. Son eventos que nos despiertan, y aun así cada uno tuvo que pasar para que Dios glorificara a Jesús y para traer la salvación a un mundo sumido en pecado (Salmo 40) por Su resurrección.

Hoy, el Domingo de Ramos, tenemos el narrativo de la Pasión como nuestro evangelio. Distinto a otros domingos, el evangelio es proclamado con la participación de usted. Nos da a todos nosotros, el padre, el diácono y usted un papel en la pasión de Cristo. Fíjese de cómo somos la multitud. Irónicamente, asistimos a condenar a Jesús al tener palmas en nuestras manos. Iniciamos como ángeles, cantando "Hosanna". Terminamos como la multitud, gritando "¡Crucifícalo!"

¡Pero no! No somos la gente más peor que ha vivido, estamos muy lejos de serlo. Para que el camino de esta Semana Santa tenga significado, debemos tomar nuestro propio lugar. Ser parte del Cuerpo de Cristo es estar con Él en la cruz. Ser miembro de la iglesia es el aceptar nuestra naturaleza pecadora y el potencial que tenemos dentro de ser buenos.

Nosotros, la Iglesia, no somos tan distintos de la multitud de gente en la crucifixión. Jesús está presente entre nosotros como estaba presente entre dos criminales pecadores, pero a la vez los dos tenían potencial de ser buenos. Uno de ellos, subió a su potencial por fe en Jesús y nos dió palabras para recordarlas en nuestras vidas: "Jesús, acuérdate de mí..."

Expectantemente, Él respondió con GRATITUD a Jesús. Dios espera que seamos AGRADECIDOS por Su amor para nosotros. Espera que seamos un DISCÍPULO AGRADECIDO. Con un corazón agradecido que es fuerte para convertir nuestro amor a Dios a un amor para otros.

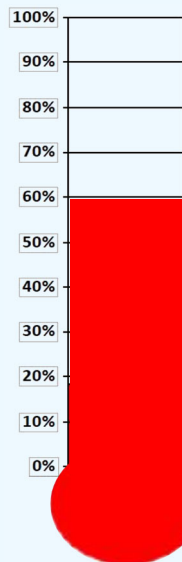

**P. Tengo entendido que los católicos de entre 18 y 59 deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo, pero ¿Cuáles son las reglas para estos ayunos?**

R. El ayuno en estos días significa que podemos tener sólo una comida completa sin carne. Otras dos comidas pequeñas se pueden comer, si es necesario, pero combinadas deben ser menos de la comida completa. Los líquidos se les permite en cualquier momento, pero comida sólida no se debe consumir entre comidas.

**P. ¿Hay excepciones afuera de la edad para el ayuno del Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo?**

R. Los que están dispensados del ayuno y abstinencia fuera de los límites de edad son gente con enfermedades físicas o mentales, incluyendo los individuos que sufren de enfermedades crónicas como la diabetes. También están excluidas las mujeres embarazadas o en lactancia. En todos los casos, el sentido común debe prevalecer, y las personas enfermas no deben poner en peligro aún más su salud por ayunar.

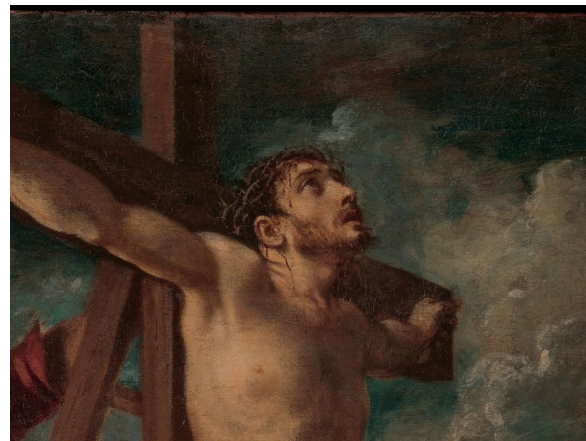

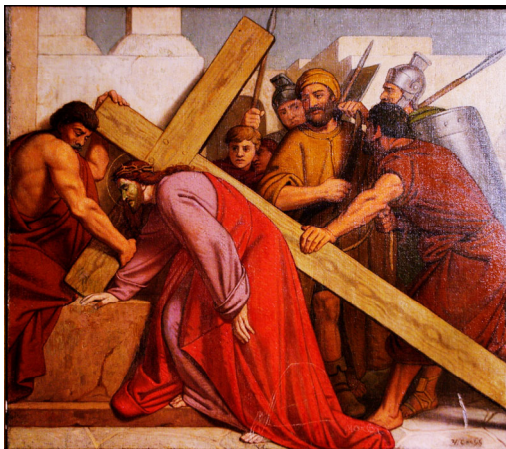

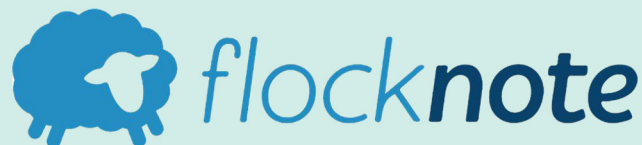
