Dear Friends in Christ,

After arriving at my parish assignment in Aurora, CO and setting up for baptisms one Saturday morning in February of 2014, I looked down at my phone to see I missed a call, but I had a voicemail. After hearing Bishop Olmsted's voice, I called back immediately and was overjoyed to hear my first assignment as a priest would be at Christ the King. As a seminarian, I had first visited the school in 2005, reading to the kids in kindergarten and first grade, who had been praying for me, and would later be my first graduating classes. I had spent many a holy hour in the St. Peregrine Shrine, and I was familiar with Fr. Steve. To be in the East Valley, close to family and friends, and beginning at a rock solid parish, I was excited! I have enjoyed immensely and with the greatest of gratitude my first years of the priesthood. You all have cared for and nurtured a "baby" priest, and I have received far more than I could have imagined from your prayers and our beautiful community.

Thank you for preparing me to serve wherever God sends. This last March I missed another phone call.

The greatest day of life was June 28, 2014 when I knelt before Bishop Olmsted and pledged obedience to him and his successors as he ordained me. My priesthood is a share in his, and his priesthood is a share in the one priesthood of Jesus Christ. As Jesus desires to be in relationship with every person, our Bishop must have a pastoral plan to care for every soul in our diocese, including our Catholic high school students, and it is my pleasure to be his co-worker. God called me to be a diocesan priest here in Phoenix and I open my heart to go where he sends under the prayer and direction of our faithful Shepherd. I will be the full-time chaplain at Bourgade Catholic High School, and I am excited to begin this new work to help the students, parents, and administration know Jesus through the sacraments, our retreats, and serving together. It is through the sacraments we will remain united together.

We are the body of Christ. Whether together or celebrating the sacraments in a different place, we can pray and intercede for one another. I will be gone but you all will not be forgotten. I will keep your intentions in my prayers, especially for a continued rock solid community. I will look forward to hearing about all your continued growth and successes, and I hope for many vocations to the priesthood and religious life. And, as I keep Fr. Rolyn and Fr. Benjamin in my prayers, I know you all will support them as well as you have me.

This is your church and community. Thank you for having me. May we continue to serve the Lord.

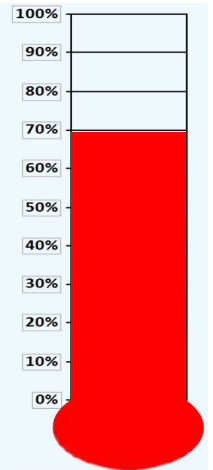

Después de escuchar la voz de nuestro Obispo Olmsted le llamé de regreso de inmediato y me llené de alegría al saber que mi primera asignación como sacerdote sería en Cristo Rey. En el 2005 ya había visitado la escuela como seminarista. Había ido a leer con los niños del kínder y primer grado que habían estado rezando por mí, y quienes más adelante serían mis primeras clases en graduarse. Había pasado muchas horas en adoración en el Santuario de San Peregrino, y ya me había familiarizado con el Padre Steve. Estaba emocionado por estar en el Este del Valle cerca de familiares y amigos y comenzar a trabajar en una parroquia fuerte. ¡Estaba emocionado! He disfrutado inmensamente y con la mayor gratitud mis primeros años en el sacerdocio. Ustedes han criado a un padre recién nacido y lo han cuidado, y yo he recibido mucho más de lo que pudiera haber imaginado con todas sus oraciones y de nuestra hermosa comunidad.

Gracias por prepararme para servir a donde Dios quiera que me envíe. Este mes de marzo perdí otra llamada.

El día más grande de mi vida fue el 28 de junio de 2014 cuando me arrodillé frente a nuestro Obispo Olmsted y prometí obediencia a él y a sus sucesores al recibir con su bendición mis órdenes sagradas. Mi sacerdocio es una participación en el sacerdocio de él. Y el sacerdocio de él es una participación en el sacerdocio de Jesucristo. Así como Jesús desea una relación con cada persona, nuestro Obispo debe tener un plan pastoral para cuidar de cada una de las almas dentro de nuestra diócesis, incluyendo nuestros estudiantes en las preparatorias católicas, y es un placer para mí colaborar con él. Dios me llamó a ser un sacerdote diocesano aquí en Phoenix y yo abro mi corazón para ir a donde sea que Él me envíe bajo la oración y dirección de nuestro fiel Pastor. Ahora voy a ser capellán tiempo completo en la Preparatoria Católica Bourgade, y estoy feliz de comenzar este nuevo trabajo para ayudar a los estudiantes, a los padres de familia y a la administración a conocer a Jesús a través de los sacramentos, de nuestros retiros espirituales y sirviendo juntos. Es a través de los sacramentos que permanecemos unidos.

Somos el cuerpo de Cristo. Ya sea estando juntos o celebrando los sacramentos en otro lugar, podemos orar e interceder unos por otros. Ya no estaré aquí, pero no me olvidaré de ustedes. Mantendré sus intenciones en mis oraciones, especialmente para la continuidad de una comunidad fuerte. Estaré pendiente de su continuo crecimiento y de sus éxitos. Espero que tengan muchas vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa. Y sé que mientras yo mantengo al P. Rolyn y al P. Benjamín en mis oraciones, sé que ustedes los apoyarán también como me han apoyado a mí.

Ésta es su iglesia y su comunidad. Gracias por tenerme aquí. Continuemos sirviendo al Señor.
