Pastoral Care Ministry

When the Church cares for the sick, it serves Christ himself in the suffering members of his Mystical Body. When it follows the example of the Lord Jesus, who “went about doing good and healing all” (Acts 10:38), the Church obeys his command to care for the sick. (Mark 16:18)

Here at Christ the King we began to intentionally build the ministry to the sick and homebound in our community over the last 2 years. Then, we had 9 volunteers who took our Lord out to those who could not attend the Mass. Today we have 26 active volunteers that serve the English speaking community, who take the Eucharist to the sick from the Mass on Sundays and Thursdays each week. We are still in need of others to help us serve the community of the sick here at Christ the King.

This summer, 10 Spanish speaking volunteers were trained and will be commissioned on September 10 at the 1pm Mass, and sent out to take the Eucharist to the sick for Christ the King.

The Diocese requires a time of training for this ministry. Our next English training is scheduled for Saturday, September 16, from 9am to 2pm. We will have a continental breakfast and will serve lunch. I ask you to prayerfully consider how you might be called to contribute and share in this much-needed ministry.

Next weekend, September 9 & 10, we will be available after all Masses to answer any questions you may have, and we will taking sign-ups for the next day of training.

Un gran porcentaje de las personas a quienes visitamos son las personas de mayor edad. La necesidad de servir a la población de personas de mayor edad es grande y sigue creciendo. Pido que consideren en oración como puede ser llamado(a) usted para contribuir y compartir en este ministerio de gran necesidad.
