My name is Elisa Chavez and I am honored to announce that I am the new LifeTeen Youth Ministry Facilitator for Christ the King.

My family and I are originally from San Diego where my husband and I both served in the United States Marine Corps. In addition, we just celebrated 16 years of sacred matrimony. We have three daughters, one dog, and a turtle and have lived in Maricopa for almost 7 years.

I am currently working towards my Master's Degree in Biblical Theology from John Paul the Great Catholic University with the hopes of graduating next winter. I graduated from the University of Mary with my BA in Theological Studies. In addition, my undergraduate studies also included several classes in psychology as well as sociology.

I have worked with at risk youth in behavioral health including suicide prevention as well as being an intern for the San Diego Youth Probation Department. Furthermore, I worked aboard Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base in Counseling Services where our office specialized in domestic violence issues. For me, these are not just a "job" one chooses, but a calling and an opportunity to provide hope, when hope is lost. To help build strong individuals and families, while teaching that circumstances do not define who we are.

On the other hand, I have volunteered to mentor and minister to women in prison. I have taught high school Confirmation classes, high School Bible classes and religious education classes for over fifteen years. I am extremely passionate about teaching youth God's Word, His teachings and how this applies to our daily lives.

One of the most important things the Marine Corps taught me is how to lead by example, however, I also learned in order to lead well one must know how to follow well, first. I understand what "Honor, Courage and Commitment" means in all parts of life. I know the importance of believing in something greater than myself and teamwork is paramount. Furthermore, I also learned how to serve others, even when I may not receive anything back in return.

I thank you for your time and I sincerely ask for your prayers as I step into this new position serving our youth and the community at Christ the King. I look forward to working with you and your families.

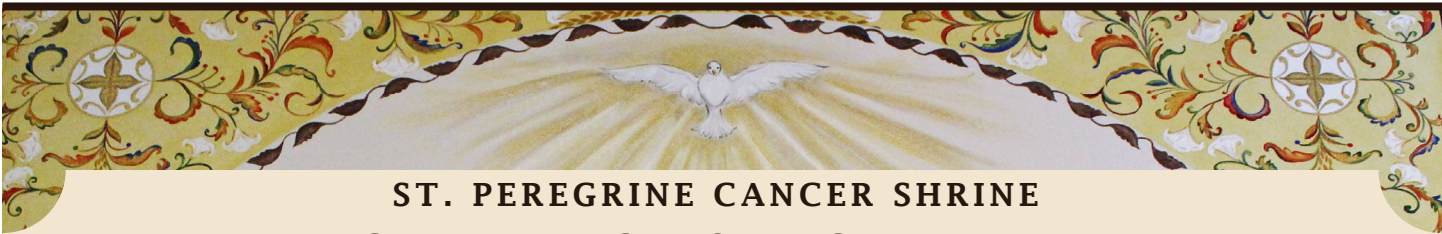

Mi nombre es Elisa Chávez y es un honor para mí anunciar que seré la nueva facilitadora del ministerio para jóvenes, LifeTeen aquí en Cristo Rey.

Mi familia y yo somos originalmente de San Diego, donde mi esposo y yo servimos en la Infantería de Marina de los Estados Unidos. Además, acabamos de celebrar 16 años de sagrado matrimonio. Tenemos tres hijas, un perro y una tortuga, y hemos vivido en Maricopa ya casi 7 años.

Actualmente estoy estudiando para recibir mi maestría en Teología Bíblica de la Universidad Católica Juan Pablo el Grande con la esperanza de recibirme el próximo invierno. Me gradué de la Universidad de María con licenciatura en Estudios de Teología. Adicionalmente, mis estudios de carrera también incluyeron varias clases en psicología así como sociología.

He trabajado con jóvenes en riesgo, en salud de comportamiento, incluyendo prevención de suicidio, así como también serví de interna para el Departamento de libertad condicional de jóvenes en San Diego. También trabajé en Servicios de terapia para la Base de la Infantería de Marina en Camp Pendleton, en donde nuestras oficinas se especializaban en problemas de violencia doméstica. Para mí, estos no son “trabajos” que uno escoge, sino un llamado y una oportunidad para dar esperanza cuando se ha perdido la esperanza. Para ayudar a edificar individuos y familias fuertes, al mismo tiempo que se les enseña que las circunstancias no son lo que define quienes somos.

Por un lado, he servido de voluntaria para orientar y servir como ministro a mujeres en prisión. He dado clases de Confirmación a nivel de preparatoria, clases de Biblia, y Catecismo durante más de quince años. Es mi gran pasión enseñar la Palabra de Dios a la juventud, Sus enseñanzas, y cómo aplicar todo esto a nuestras vidas diarias.

Una de las cosas más importantes que me ha enseñado la Infantería de Marina es cómo guiar con ejemplo, aunque también he aprendido que para poder guiar bien, uno debe saber antes cómo seguir bien. Sé lo que significa “el honor, la valentía y el compromiso” en todas las áreas de la vida. Sé la importancia de creer en algo más grande que lo que soy, y que el trabajo en equipo es de suma importancia. Además, también he aprendido cómo servir al prójimo, aún cuando yo no reciba nada a cambio.

Les agradezco su tiempo y pido de corazón sus oraciones mientras tomo esta nueva posición para servir a nuestra juventud y la comunidad en Cristo Rey. Espero con gusto trabajar con ustedes y sus familias.

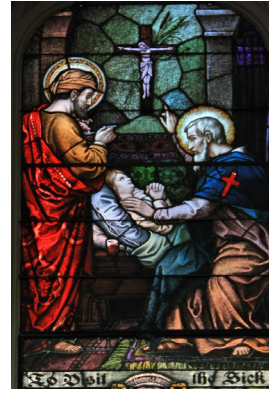
