St. Vincent de Paul's programs strive to Feed, Clothe, House and Heal deeply and meaningfully. One visit at a time, the visit in the home lays a welcome mat of service, relationship and hope.

In February of 2017, a conference of Vincentians here at Christ the King was formed, committing to the sharing of their lives for the service of those in need in our community. They have come together with your help to serve over one hundred families.

St. Vincent de Paul Christ the King Conference was established less than a year ago and we've had the privilege of helping over *one hundred families* with their rent and utilities.

Christ the King is blessed with the H.O.P.E. food ministry, and we are also able to connect the families with all the local resources to meet their needs.

All of this has been possible only because of the generous Christ the King parishioners who have provided us funds via the second collection at Mass every three months. We assist six families per week, which requires about \$1,800, yet our need within our parish boundaries is at least three times that number. We are blessed to be able to pray with each of the families. Their gratitude expressed to you, the parishioners, who make this possible, is humbling.

We need your continued support of this work to provide this service and help to those in need.

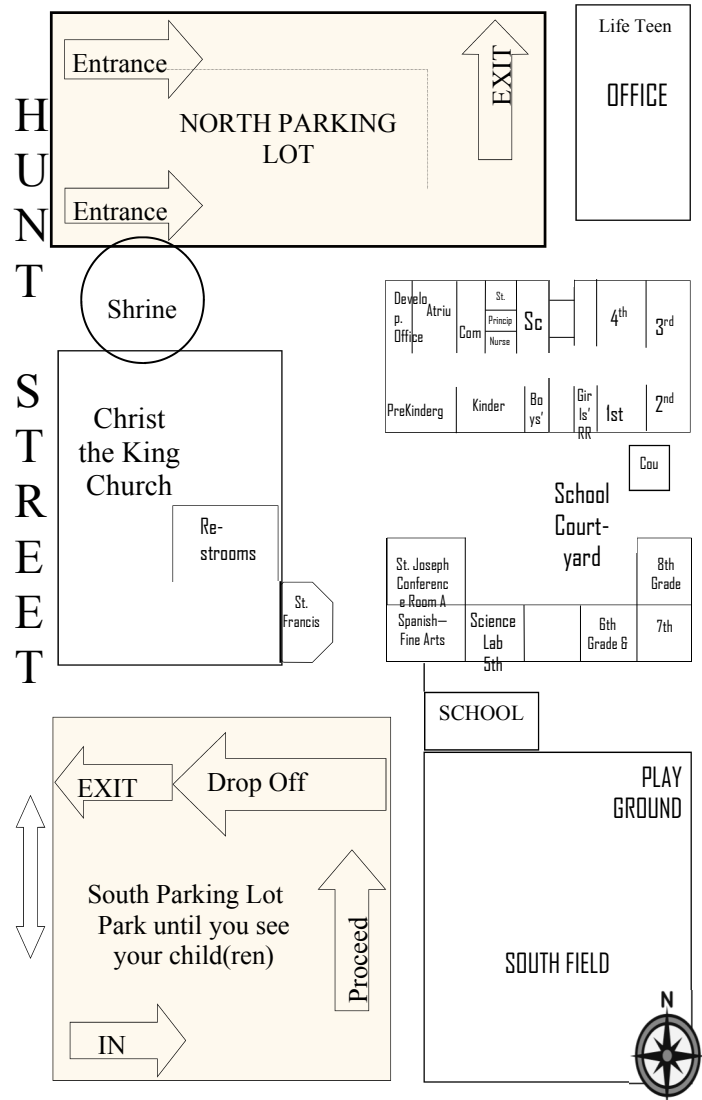

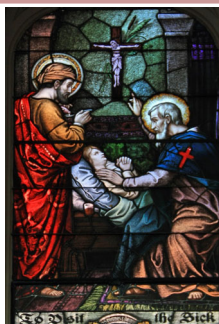

### Voluntarios para el Cuidado Pastoral

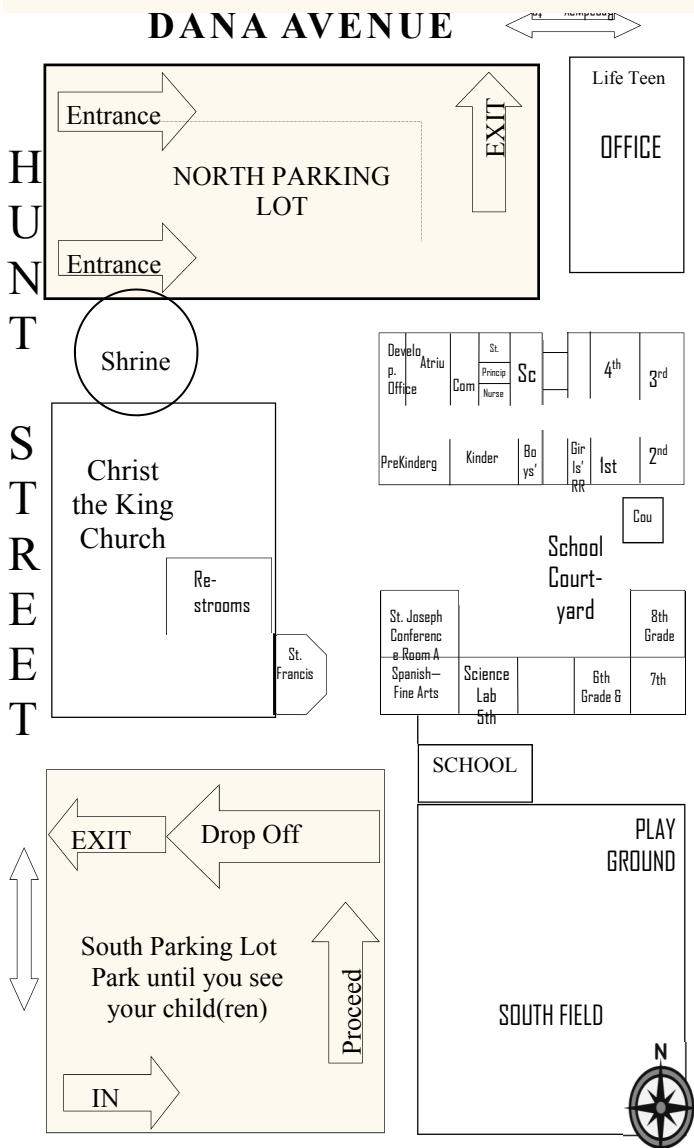
