## St. Peregrine Cancer Shrine Celebrates its 8<sup>th</sup> Year Anniversary

*We have so much to be thankful for, and this year is a great celebration!  
A celebration of **you** and the harvest of your labor.*

In the Shrine we were given an invitation to participate in our Lord's saving mission. We are invited to grow in love with our Lord, our God, and to go out and love our neighbors with the grace of that love. The Shrine provides us with opportunities to sit and be with our Lord, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. For a community to have Perpetual Adoration is a gift in itself.

The ministries that serve the Shrine continue to grow in number of those who participate in the work of praying for those who suffer from cancer, those who commit to Holy Hours, those who pray for others, those who craft the prayer shawls, package and mail them out, those who process the requests, those who manage the prayer wall, address and mail out the cards, and to those who have generously given financially to the shrine, we say thank you. An estimation of over 93,000 plus volunteer hours since 2010 have been shared.

The Lord invited you... to participate in the mission of the Shrine and you responded with a yes! 3,259 prayer requests have been responded to, and over 84,000 cards have been mailed out to homes across the United States and 15 countries. 1,851 shawls and blankets crafted in prayer have been shipped out. Other faith communities have joined us in the creation of these gifts of prayer. We now have a processing center to help us respond to the request for shawls and blankets, and are recruiting new volunteers to assist with this branch of the ministry.

When I sit and reflect on the Shrine and the gifts of love that flow out to others, I am overwhelmed with awe and consider myself so blessed to be able to participate in this work.

Now I invite you to come and celebrate with us the many blessings we have received in the gift of the shrine. Let us go before the Lord and give him praise; let our lives continue to bless him.

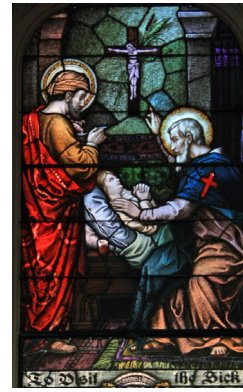
