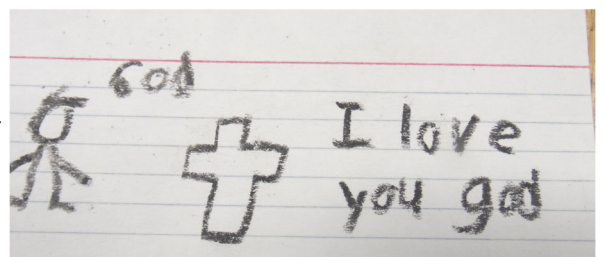
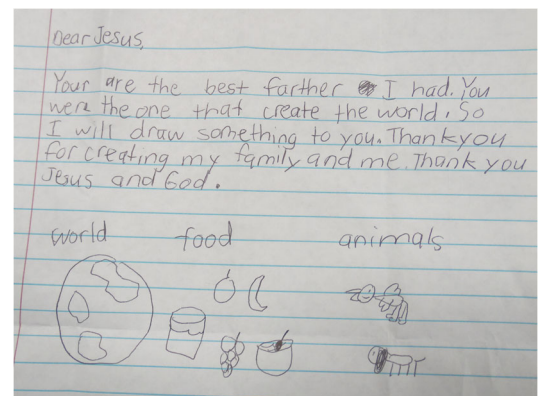
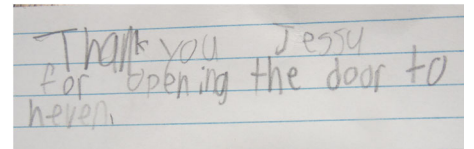


Un espíritu de generosidad brilla a través de los niños

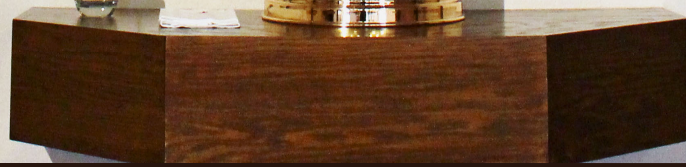

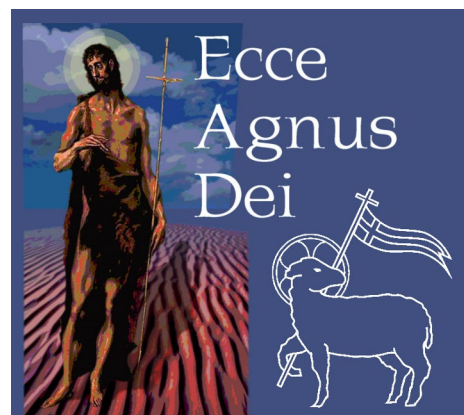

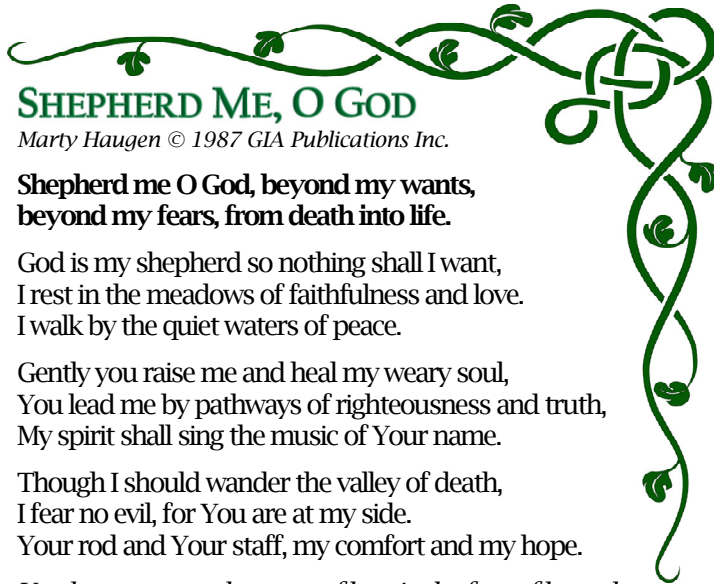
