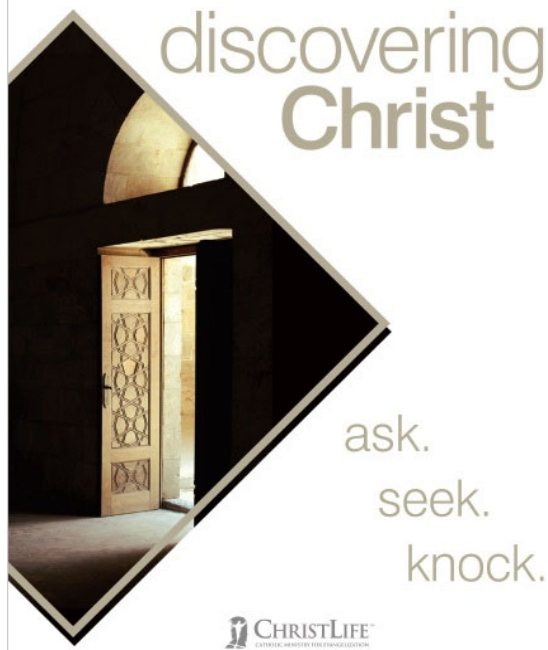

ALL: We sing God's praises our light has come.

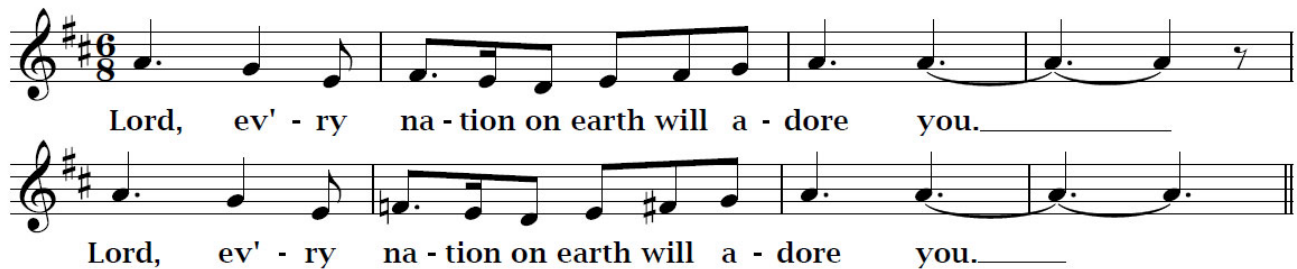
Though darkness covers and we are blinded by sin.
