## PALM SUNDAY

Dear parishioners,

I wish to draw attention to the historical context of Palm Sunday, which we celebrate each year to begin Holy Week.

In the Four Gospels we read about the event when Jesus arrived in Jerusalem, which we celebrate and remember as “Palm Sunday.”

Jesus and his disciples slept in Bethany (Mk 14, 1–ss) and with the sunrise left for Jerusalem, where there were for sure a great number of people arriving in caravans from everywhere for the Passover. Their hearts must have been full of joy—like any Jew who came to the Holy City—they came with an open heart.

It is in these conditions when Jesus decides to enter Jerusalem as King. This was not usual of Him; it even seems that He plans it and it makes one feel enthused.

So, they left early in the morning from Bethany walking slowly, saying psalms and prayers as it was the custom for every pilgrim who came to the Holy City. They had taken the shortest road, which is still known today, from Bethany to Jerusalem. It is about two miles and reaches the Mount of Olives; from there it quickly descends to the golden gate and into the temple—west of the City of Jerusalem. This way, they had to cross Kedron Brook (known in the past as Josafat Valley, where final judgement was to take place according to the Prophet Joel 4:12).

In this context, Jesus decides to enter the Holy City of Jerusalem riding a donkey, which in those times was not a rustic animal as we consider it today, but rather a noble animal—more so if no one had ridden it yet. It was not a ride either for a prince of this world, who rather rode on horse accompanied by flamboyant guards. Jesus arrives as the **PRINCE OF PEACE**, whom the Prophet Zachariah had announced (Zac 9:9).

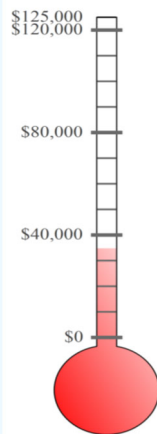

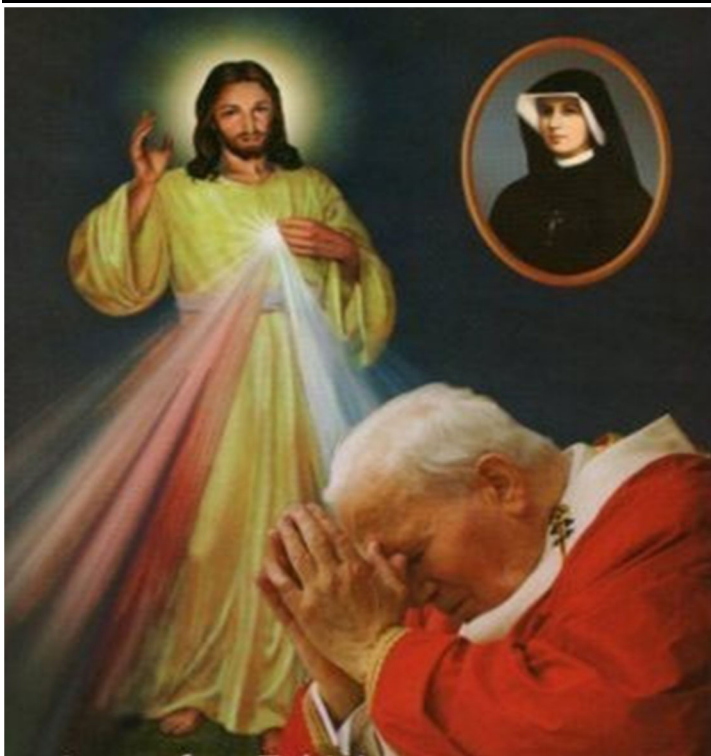

## DOMINGO DE RAMOS

Queridos feligreses,

Deseo recordar un poco el contexto histórico del Domingo de Ramos, que nosotros celebramos cada año para iniciar la Semana Santa.

En los cuatro Evangelios se nos narra el acontecimiento de la entrada de Jesús a Jerusalén, que nosotros celebramos y recordamos como “Domingo de Ramos.”

Jesús y los suyos durmieron en Betania (Mc 14, 1–ss) y con la mañana salieron a Jerusalén, donde de seguro había un gran número de personas llegando en caravanas de todos lados para las fiestas de la Pascua. Los corazones de todos debieron estar alegres y llenos de júbilo, como todo judío que se acerca a la Ciudad Santa; iban con el alma abierta.

Y es en estas condiciones cuando Jesús decide entrar a Jerusalén como Rey. Esta manera no era lo habitual en Él, incluso parece que hasta lo planea Él mismo y le llena de entusiasmo.

Entonces, salieron de mañana de Betania caminando despacio, recitando salmos y oraciones como era costumbre en todo peregrino que se acerca a la Ciudad Santa. Habían tomado el camino más corto que aún hoy se conoce y va de Betania a Jerusalén. Son unos 3 kilómetros (poco menos de 2 millas) y se llega al “monte de los olivos” y desde allí un rápido descenso que conduce hasta la puerta dorada y luego al templo—es actualmente por el poniente de la ciudad de Jerusalén (el west). De esta manera había que cruzar en torrente Cedrón (antiguamente conocido como el Valle de Josafat, donde debía celebrarse el juicio final dicho por el Profeta Joel 4:12.

En este contexto Jesús decide entrar a la Ciudad Santa de Jerusalén, montado en borriquillo, que en aquel entonces no era un animal rústico como ahora lo consideramos, sino animal noble—más si aún nadie lo había montado. Tampoco era la montura de un príncipe de este mundo, que entraba a caballo con guardias vistosos. Jesús entra como el **“PRINCIPE DE LA PAZ,”** ya anunciado por el Profeta Zacarías 9:9.

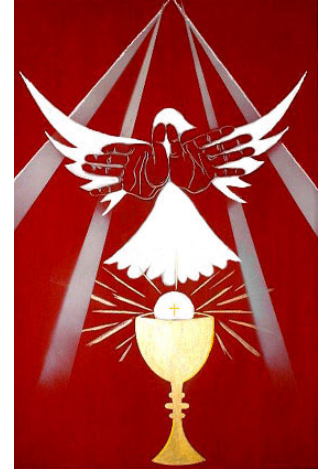
## HOW DEEP THE FATHER'S LOVE

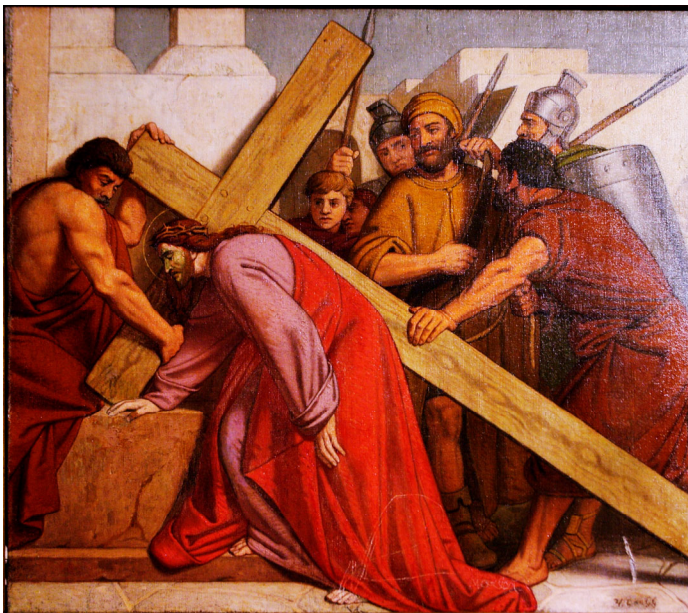
