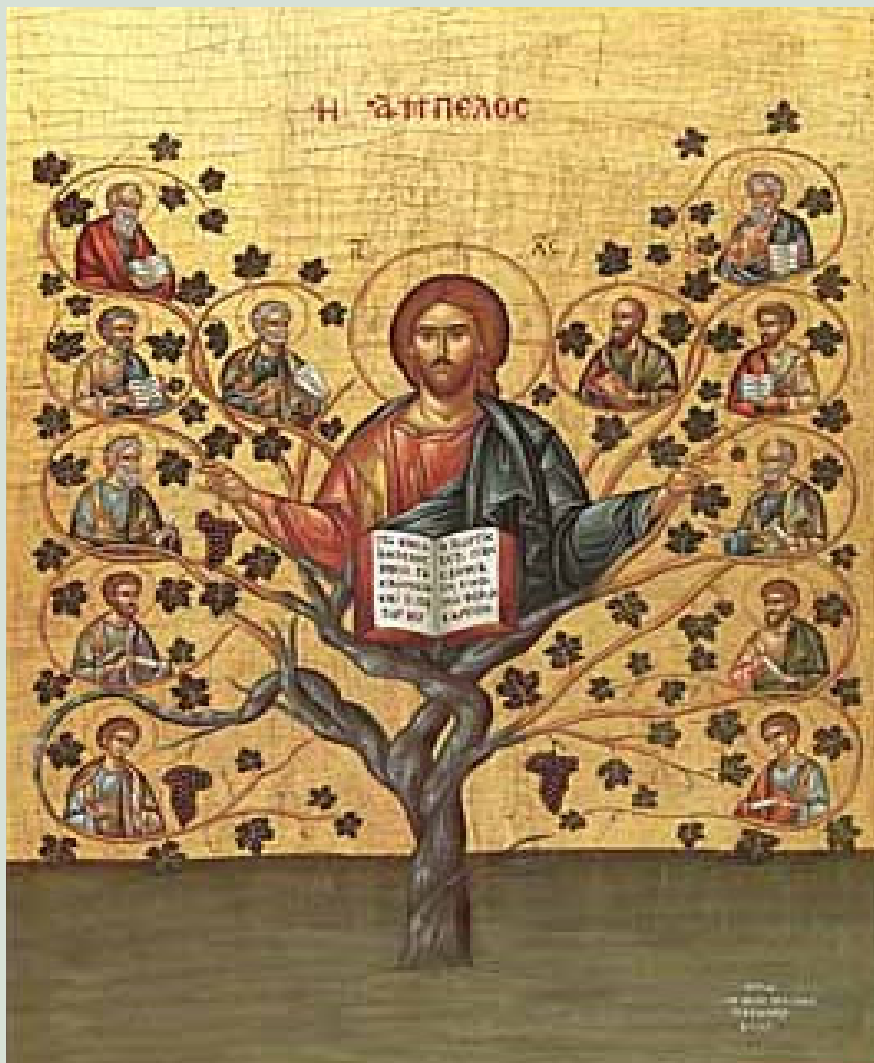



## Stay Connected to Jesus

There is an American Indian story, which is so familiar to many of you. A young man found an eagle's egg and put it into the nest of a prairie chicken. The eaglet hatched with the brood of prairie chickens and grew up with them. All its life, the misplaced eagle thought it was a prairie chicken and did only what the prairie chickens did. It scratched in the dirt for seeds and insects to eat. And it flew no more than a few feet off the ground with a thrashing of wings like other prairie chickens. Years passed and the unfortunate eagle grew very old. One day, it saw a magnificent bird high above in the cloudless sky. Hanging with graceful majesty on the powerful wind currents, it soared gracefully on its strong golden wings. "What a beautiful bird!" said the unfortunate eagle to its neighbor. "That's an eagle, the chief of the birds," the neighbor replied, "but don't give it a second thought. You could never be like him." So the poor eagle never gave it a second thought and it died thinking it was a prairie chicken.

The American Indian story underlies the importance of what we identify ourselves with. Our readings today are invitations to stay connected to Jesus, to remain in him and to be identified with Him and bear fruit. The misguided eagle was like a branch grafted on a false or imperfect vine. That is why it remained false or imperfect all its life. If a wise bird had told it the truth about itself it would have shifted its self-identification from that of a prairie chicken to that of an eagle. This radical shift in self-understanding would then enable it to produce in its life the marvelous feats for which eagles are known. Today that word of wisdom is being addressed to us: to stop identifying ourselves primarily in terms of the most popular vines of our times, like, materialism, religious cults, or power, among others. Rather we should see ourselves in terms of our oneness with Christ just as the branches and the vine are one. Then and only then shall we be able to bear good fruit, the same type of fruit that Christ himself bears.

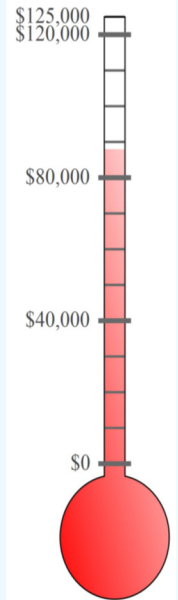

## Charles Passe Scholarship for Post-High School Education

Charles Passe began his association with Christ the King Parish in 1981 after moving from Minnesota to Tucson, then to Mesa where he continued his love of woodworking.

Mr. Passe set up this endowment in 1994, and his commitment to young people and their success lives on through this endowed scholarship. Any Christ the King registered parishioner that is pursuing post-high school trade or vocational education (IT, automotive, dental, construction are a few examples) is eligible. The size of the award will be based on the number of qualified applicants.

The Charles Passe Scholarship Fund is managed by the Catholic Community Foundation for Christ the King Parish.



## Mantente conectado con Jesús

Hay un cuento Nativo Americano, que quizás conocen. Un joven se encontró un huevo de águila y lo colocó adentro de un nido de una gallina salvaje. El aguilucho nació y creció junto con las gallinas salvajes. Toda su vida, el aguilucho extraviado pensó que era una gallina salvaje y hacía sólo lo que las gallinas salvajes hacían; rascaba la tierra para buscar semillas e insectos para comer. Y volaba no más de unos cuantos pies de alto azotando las alas como las demás gallinas salvajes. Pasaron los años y la desafortunada águila se envejeció. Un día, vio un pájaro magnífico volar alto en el cielo despejado. Con elegante majestuosidad se dejaba deslizar con las fuertes corrientes de aire; planeaba con gracia utilizando sus fuertes alas doradas. “¡Qué hermoso pájaro!” dijo la desafortunada águila a su vecino. “Ese es un águila, jefe de los pájaros,” replicó el vecino, “pero ni lo pienses, tú nunca podrías ser como él.” Así que el pobre águila jamás lo volvió a pensar y murió creyendo que era una gallina salvaje.

El cuento Nativo Americano subraya la importancia de aquello con lo cual nos identificamos. Las lecturas de hoy son invitaciones a mantenernos conectados con Jesús, a permanecer en Él y a identificarnos con Él y dar fruto. El águila mal informada era como un sarmiento injerto en una vid falsa o imperfecta. Por eso siempre estuvo equivocado o imperfecto toda su vida. Si un pájaro sabio le hubiese dicho la verdad acerca de lo que era, hubiera cambiado su identificación propia de ser una gallina salvaje, a ser un águila. Este cambio radical en su entendimiento propio lo hubiese habilitado para producir en su vida las hazañas maravillosas por las cuales se conocen las águilas. Hoy día, esa sabiduría es la que se nos enseña: dejar de identificarnos con lo que son las viñas más populares de nuestros tiempos, como el materialismo, los cultos religiosos, o el poder, entre otras. Debemos identificarnos en términos de nuestra unidad con Cristo así como los sarmientos y la vid son uno mismo. Únicamente entonces podremos dar fruto bueno, el mismo fruto que Cristo mismo da.

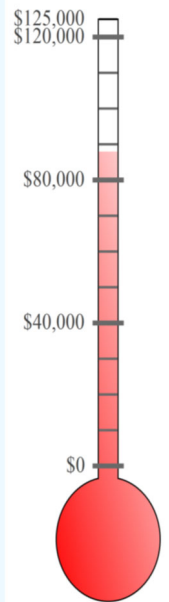
