Religious Education



As God's tremendous love and blessings fill each one's lives, I weave carefully the moments of my life with gratitude. Each day I give thanks to God for all His blessings and His Providence. It has been a great joy to work with so many volunteers who form our children in the Catholic Faith. I want to express my heartfelt gratitude to all our volunteers for their great work with our children.

The children come to classes with great joy and enthusiasm to know Jesus, Our Good Shepherd. We truly witness a transformation in them as we teach them on their journey of faith. I also express my gratitude to the parents/guardians who showed their support and love to their children in this process.

There were over 430 students in our Religious Education (RE) Program this past school year in grades Pre-K through 8. At the Easter Vigil, 40 students, including two students from the Catholic School, were baptized, confirmed and received First Holy Communion; over 160 students made their First Confession on April 21 and 23 Catholic School students on March 5; over 150 students, 30 Catholic School students, 13 RCIT, 7 RCIA and 6 RICA received First Communion and Confirmation last May 4, 5 and May 12. Last Sunday, Bella Grazia Tea Party went well. Our young people came with their moms and/or someone important in their lives.

Thank you, our children, for being wonderful students eager to learn the Faith and show the joy of your heart to love Jesus. Parents, thank you for your willingness to help in many ways. Now it's summer, but we all know we are not vacationing from our Faith Life. Without prayer we cannot grow in our relationship with the Lord. So let's make prayer a central part of our everyday life.

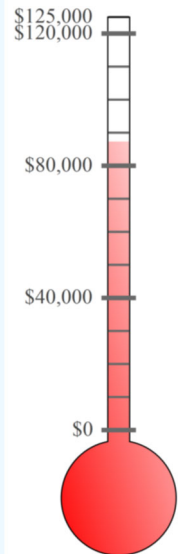

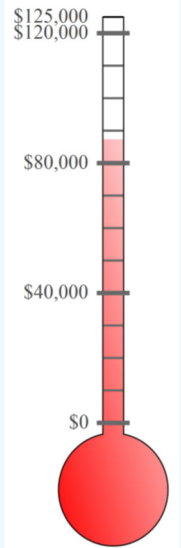

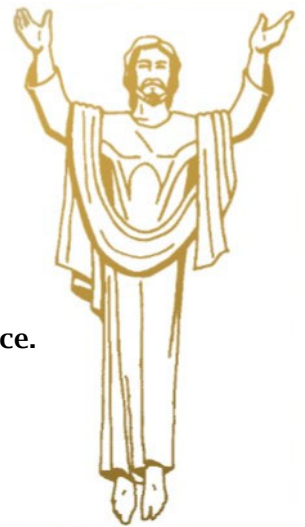
