In observance of Pentecost, we celebrate sanctification,  
the infusion of The Holy Spirit, and the birth of the Church

The riches of the Holy Spirit are infinite because He is a divine person. The Holy Spirit is divine mystery; He is felt by His actions, His effects, although invisible, are very real. The Holy Spirit has been poured down over the Church like perfume. Perfume is not seen, but its presence is felt, it fills everything.

Given that the Spirit is intangible and invisible, The Scripture talks about His presence with symbols such as water, wind, and fire. Let us focus on fire for the moment.

John the Baptist talks about Jesus as the One who will “baptize...with the Holy Spirit and fire” (Mt 3,11). And this promise is fulfilled on Pentecost: “Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire... and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit.” (Acts 2, 3). Also, in the words of Jesus: “I have come to set the earth on fire...” (Lk 12, 49) He is referring to the gift of The Spirit. But, what is the meaning of fire in the Bible? It gives light, it gives heat, it gives warmth, it ignites, etc. There is a meaning that stands out over all the others: fire purifies. Fire purifies in a radical and deep way.

From the Prophet Isaiah: “I will refine your dross in the furnace” (Is 1, 25).

The Spirit is fire because He is Holy. That is why the Church talks about Pentecost in the Liturgy as “a mystery of sanctification and of love”.

St. Cyril of Jerusalem says that on Pentecost, the apostles received the “fire that burns the spine of sinners and gives radiance to the soul”. But, how does it burn sins away without burning the sinner? It does not consume the sinner’s nature, but rather purifies it”.

When Jesus, after rising, appears to the disciples and says: “Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them..” (Jn 20, 22b-23a), He is not giving the Church an external “legal” power, but rather a real and intrinsic power, which is The Holy Spirit.

But, do we really want to be purified? Pope Benedict XVI pointed out that many men have the desire to come near to God, and to know Jesus Christ, but at the same time, are afraid to be “purified by the fire”. “The flame of the Holy Spirit burns, but does not set ablaze. Nevertheless, it transforms, and that is why it must consume something within man, the dross that corrupts him and is an obstacle to his relationship with God and with neighbor. But this effect of the divine fire scares us. We are afraid of being “burned” - we would prefer to remain as we are.

Many people believe in God and admire the figure of Jesus, but are afraid of the demands of the faith.

On one side, we want to be with Jesus, follow him closely; and on the other, we are afraid of the consequences of doing so.

Just as Simon Peter and the rest of the disciples, we must let His presence and His grace transform our hearts, and say: Holy Spirit, enkindle in us the fire of your love!

We need the fire of The Holy Spirit because only Love redeems.


### **Carmel's Corner**

En Solemnidad de Pentecostés, celebramos la infusión del Espíritu Santo, la santificación y el nacimiento de la Iglesia

La riqueza del Espíritu Santo es infinita por tratarse de una persona divina. El Espíritu Santo es misterio divino, que se deja sentir por sus actos, por sus efectos que, aunque invisibles, son realísimos. El Espíritu Santo ha sido derramado sobre la Iglesia como perfume. El perfume no se ve, pero se siente su presencia, lo llena todo.

Dado que el Espíritu es intangible e invisible, la misma Escritura habla de su presencia con símbolos como agua, viento y fuego. Vamos a centrarnos solamente en el fuego.

Juan Bautista habla de Jesús como el que “bautizará con Espíritu Santo y fuego” (Mt 3,11). Y esta promesa se cumple en Pentecostés: “Aparecieron lenguas como de fuego... Todos quedaron llenos de Espíritu Santo” (Hc 2, 3). También la palabra de Jesús: “He venido a traer fuego sobre la tierra” (Lc 12, 49) se refiere al don del Espíritu. Pero, ¿cuál es el sentido del fuego en la Biblia? Ilumina, calienta, inflama, etc., hay un sentido que destaca sobre todos: el fuego purifica, el fuego purifica de una manera radical, hasta lo más profundo.

El profeta Isaías: “Te purificaré de escorias en el crisol” (Is 1, 25).

El Espíritu es fuego porque es Santo. Por eso, la Iglesia habla de Pentecostés en su liturgia como “misterio de santificación y de amor”.

S. Cirilo de Jerusalén dice que en Pentecostés, los apóstoles recibieron el “fuego que quema las espinas de los pecados y da esplendor al alma”. Pero, ¿cómo quema los pecados sin destruir al pecador? no consume la naturaleza sino que la purifica”.

Cuando Jesús resucitado se aparece a los discípulos y les dice: “Recibid el Espíritu Santo, a quienes perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados” (Jn 20), no está dando a la Iglesia un poder “legal”, jurídico, externo. Sino que le entregó un poder real, intrínseco que es el Espíritu Santo.

Pero ¿queremos nosotros purificarnos de verdad? El Papa Benedicto XVI señalaba que muchos hombres sienten deseo de acercarse a Dios, de conocer a Jesucristo. Pero, al mismo tiempo, tienen miedo de ser “purificados por el fuego”. “La llama del Espíritu Santo arde pero no quema. Y, sin embargo, realiza una transformación y, por eso, debe consumir algo en el hombre, las escorias que lo corrompen y obstaculizan sus relaciones con Dios y con el prójimo. Pero este efecto del fuego divino nos asusta, tenemos miedo de que nos «queme», preferiríamos permanecer tal como somos.

Muchas personas creen en Dios y admiran la figura de Jesucristo, pero tienen miedo de las exigencias de la fe. Por un lado, queremos estar con Jesús, seguirlo de cerca; y, por otro, tenemos miedo de las consecuencias que eso conlleva.

Como Simón Pedro y los demás, debemos dejar que su presencia y su gracia transformen nuestro corazón, y digamos: Espíritu Santo! ¡Enciende en nosotros el fuego de tu amor!

Necesitamos el fuego del Espíritu Santo, porque sólo el Amor redime”






