Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

One of the most important things we can provide our Catholic youth is a firm foundation in the Faith. “With such a foundation, they can approach life with a sense of purpose, identity, and hope; without it, anything they might accomplish in life does not add up to much. They might acquire money, but with no sense of meaning; fame, but with no sense of who they are; success, but with no final goal in mind.”

Recently I have been asked how we teach the Church’s teachings to our young people who are moving so fast in a secular world. The answer is we reclaim our culture. We do this by using every tool to share the message of Christ that they are loved by God the Father right here and right now. Although our approach might be new, the message is “ever ancient, ever new.” The truth is young people crave greatness.

Christ the King currently has weekly classes for high school students, grades 9-12 who desire to receive their sacraments in the Catholic Church in addition to Life Teen on Sundays. Life Teen believes that “Eucharist-based ministry has the power to transform teens, parishes and a culture.”

Beginning this fall, junior high school students, grades 6-8 will also move to the same model under Life Teen, which is relational ministry. This means that these students will continue to receive their sacraments; however, they will also be offered EDGE. EDGE is the youth ministry component for junior high students.

With a grateful heart we are anticipating over 105 junior high students in Christ the King’s RCIC program in the fall. As disciples, we are called to witness, and our mission is to "Go... and make disciples of all nations... (Mt 28:19) As the youth minister and sacrament facilitator of Christ the King, I am inviting you to prayerfully consider joining me in this effort to “lead our youth into relationship with Christ” by being a catechist or core member.

To be a catechist or core member we ask that you first have an open heart and a passion for Christ’s mission to empower our young people to be saints and kingdom builders. Training will be provided. On the other hand, there are numerous ways for you to be a part of this exciting and rewarding ministry. Please call me at 480-844-4476 to set up an appointment to meet.

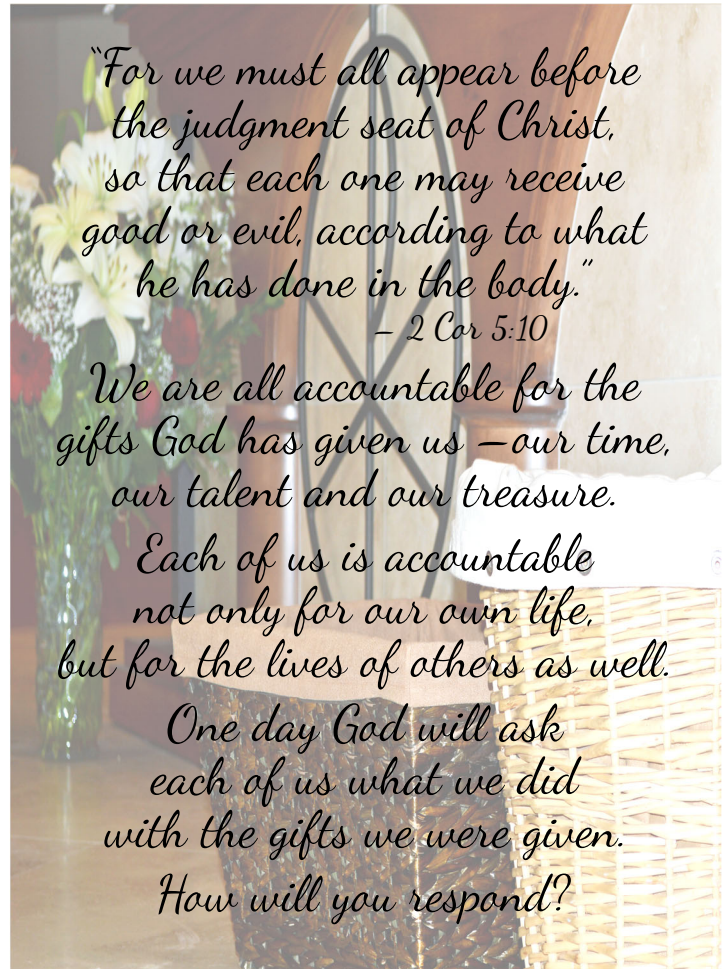

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Una de las cosas más importantes que podemos dar a nuestra juventud católica es un cimiento firme en la Fe. “Con un cimiento firme, ellos pueden abordar la vida con un sentido de propósito, identidad y esperanza; sin él, cualquier cosa que pudieran lograr en la vida, no lleva a mucho. Puede que ganen dinero, pero sin gran entendimiento de significado; fama, pero sin entendimiento de quiénes son realmente; éxito, pero sin una meta final en mente.”

Recientemente me han preguntado cómo es que educamos en las enseñanzas de la Iglesia a nuestros jóvenes que se encuentran moviéndose tan rápido en un mundo secular. La respuesta es: recuperamos nuestra cultura. Hacemos esto utilizando cada herramienta para compartir el mensaje de Cristo de que son amados por Dios Padre aquí y ahora. Aunque nuestra estrategia puede ser nueva, el mensaje es “tan antiguo y a la misma vez tan nuevo.” La verdad es que los jóvenes anhelan grandeza.

Aquí en Cristo Rey tenemos clases semanales para estudiantes de preparatoria de 9° á 12° grado de high school que desean recibir sus sacramentos en la Iglesia Católica además del grupo Life Teen los domingos. En Life Teen creemos que “un ministerio basado en la Eucaristía tiene el poder para transformar a jóvenes, a parroquias y a una cultura.”

Comenzando este otoño, los estudiantes de 6° á 8° grado de junior high, también tendrán el mismo modelo bajo el programa de Life Teen, que es un ministerio de relación. Esto significa que estos estudiantes continuarán recibiendo sus sacramentos; sin embargo, también se les ofrecerá el programa EDGE. EDGE es el componente del ministerio de jóvenes de secundaria.

Con un corazón agradecido estamos anticipando a más de 105 estudiantes de secundaria en el programa de RCIC (Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Niños) en Cristo Rey para el otoño. Como discípulos, somos llamados a ser testigos, y nuestra misión es “Ir... y hacer discípulos a todas las naciones...” (Mt 28:19). Como ministro de jóvenes y facilitadora de sacramentos en Cristo Rey, les hago la invitación para considerar en oración unirse a este esfuerzo para “guiar a nuestros jóvenes a una relación con Cristo” siendo uno de los catequistas para jóvenes, o “core member”.

Para poder ser catequista, pedimos que antes se tenga un corazón abierto y una pasión por la misión de Cristo de fortalecer a la juventud para ser santos y edificadores del reino. También se dará un entrenamiento. Por otra parte, hay numerosas maneras en que se puede formar parte de este emocionante y gratificante ministerio. 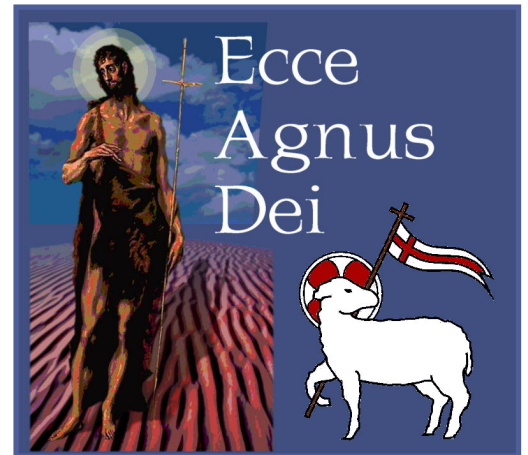

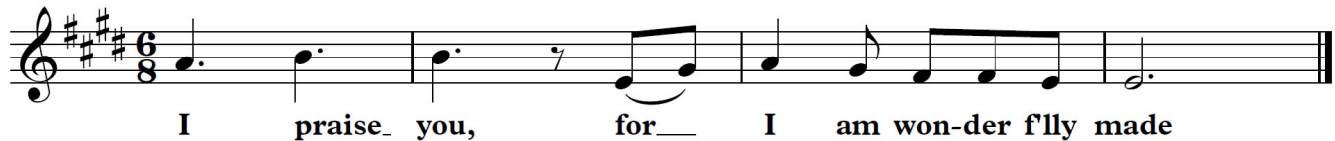
