Do you have an hour once a week, once a month, or even every other month, that you could be a Substitute Adorer?

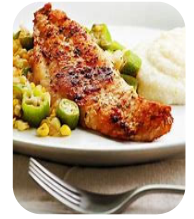
If a Substitute is needed, you would get a Substitute request email, but only for the day(s) of the week and the time of day that you specify you are available.
