Thank You Very Much for the School Supplies!

A 7-year old kid will wake up early at 5:00 am, then prepare to go to school. Accompanied by his or her mom, if not an older sister or a brother, he will leave early, walking through the rice fields, crossing the stream or river and mountain to reach the school. He does this like many other students because he doesn't want to be late. While walking, they share laughter so they do not have a tiring walk to school. They can take a motorbike ride or a tricycle ride but want to save some money for their lunch or school needs.

Even then, food is shared by siblings. They have to wait for each other during lunch break and share together their packed lunch, as always, rice and dried fish. They are lucky if there is a piece of boiled egg, which they cut into halves and share.

In the village, children cross the stream and walk by foot during rainy days. But during heavy rains they can't cross the rivers or streams unless there are bridges. They have to wait until the water subsides. They use banana leaves to cover themselves from rain. They keep extra clothes in their bag, which is wrapped with plastic. Walking through the woods and the fields, or crossing the mountains during the rainy season, sometimes they encounter snakes. But they are not as afraid seeing the snakes as they are of destroying their slippers. Buying a pair of slippers is, for them, expensive.

Opening of school year is a big challenge, especially to parents. Most of them worry where to get school supplies, for their income from selling their farm products or as tenant workers is not enough to provide for their children's education. Some earn a monthly income of \$18.00 more or less. But their children's perseverance and determination are so inspiring that parents work hard for them.

Coming from this situation, and knowing how it feels to have nothing, I am inspired to help these school children. Besides helping those in the remote villages, I also sent two similar boxes of school supplies, backpacks, and slippers to students in poor communities in Metro Manila a couple of months ago.

Thank you very much for your generosity. You help bring these children to a brighter future.

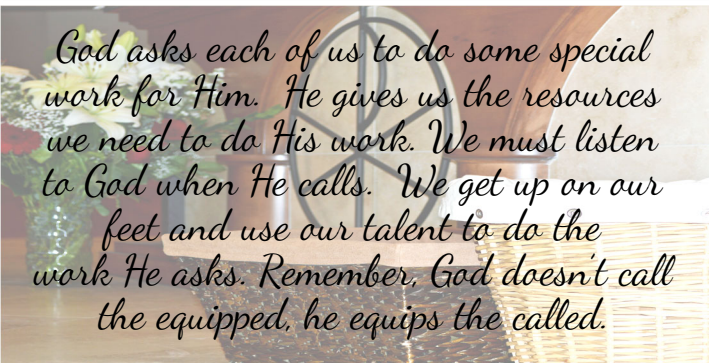

¡Muchísimas gracias por los útiles escolares!

Un niño de 7 años se levanta temprano a las 5:00 am, y se prepara para ir a la escuela. Acompañado por su mamá, o un hermano mayor, saldrá temprano, caminando entre campos de arroz, cruzando riachuelos o ríos y un monte para llegar a la escuela. Esto hacen de igual manera muchos otros estudiantes porque no quieren llegar tarde. Al ir caminando, comparten risas para no aburrirse de camino a la escuela. Pueden tomar un aventón en motocicleta pero quieren ahorrar algo de dinero para su comida, útiles, o lo que necesiten para la escuela.

Aún así, comparten comida entre hermanos. Tienen que esperarse durante el recreo y así poder compartir su comida, como de costumbre, arroz y pescado seco. Tienen suerte si hay un huevo cocido, el cual parten a la mitad para compartir.

En el pueblo, los niños cruzan el riachuelo y caminan a pie durante los días lluviosos. Pero durante las lluvias fuertes no pueden cruzar los ríos ni riachuelos a menos de que haya algún puente. Tienen que esperar a que baje el agua. Usan hojas de plátano para cubrirse de la lluvia. Ellos llevan un cambio de ropa en su bolsa, que está cubierta en plástico. A veces, durante las lluvias, al ir caminando por los bosques y campos, o al cruzar el monte, les salen víboras. Pero no les da tanto miedo ver las víboras como les da que se les rompan sus sandalias. Para ellos, comprar un par de chanclas es caro.

El comienzo del año escolar es un gran reto, especialmente para los padres de familia. La mayoría se preocupa en dónde van a conseguir útiles escolares, pues el ingreso que reciben por la venta de los productos de su granja o del ingreso que reciben como inquilinos, no es suficiente para pagar la educación de sus hijos. Algunos tienen un ingreso mensual de \$18.00 más o menos. Pero la perseverancia y determinación de sus hijos los inspira tanto que ellos trabajan duro por ellos.

Viniendo de esta situación, y sabiendo lo que se siente no tener nada, me inspira ayudar a estos niños estudiantes. Además de ayudar a aquellos que viven en pueblos remotos, también he enviado dos cajas parecidas de útiles escolares, mochilas y sandalias a los estudiantes de las comunidades pobres en la ciudad de Manila hace un par de meses.

¡Muchas gracias por su generosidad y por ayudar a acercar a estos niños a un futuro más prometedor!

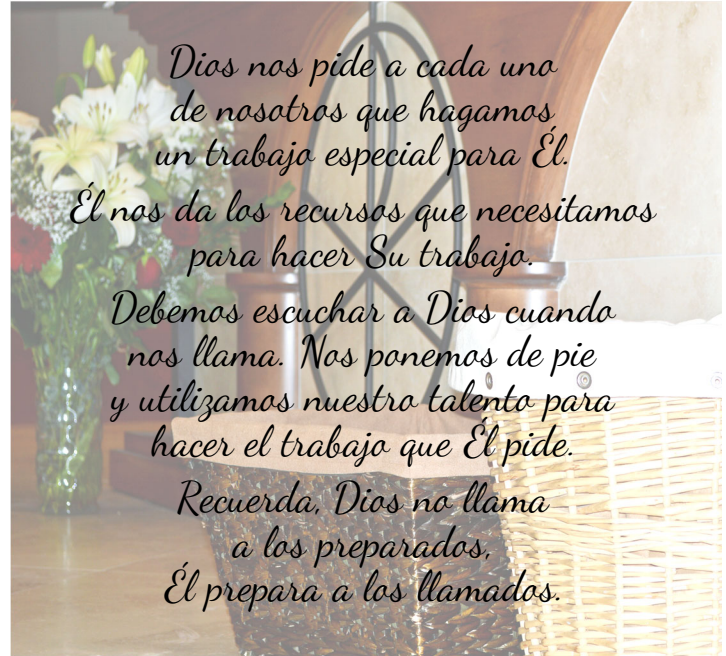

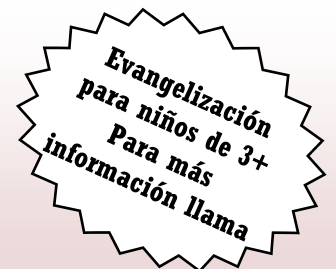

All things are mine since I am His; how can I keep from singing?



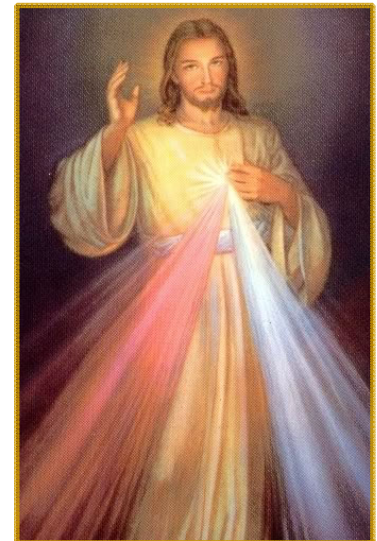
