Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

What a busy summer it has been for us involved in RCIT and Life Teen here at Christ the King. I would first like to thank all of our Envelop prayer partners and the Knights of Columbus for their support and prayers. Please know that we have also been praying for your specific intentions. It is because of your prayers and support that we were able to kick off the summer with movie night, and family water day here on campus, Night Sunsplash at Golfland, Catholic Youth Congreso promoted by the Diocesan Hispanic Leadership Office, the University of Mary Summer Institute, and, most recently, Steubenville West, held at the campus of University of Arizona. We experienced this conference with over 2000 teens, youth ministers, core members, volunteers and priests from various other states. One of our teens also attended LEAD prior to Steubenville West. *Franciscan LEAD is a five-day, Christ-centered, sacrament-soaked, prayer-fueled immersion in Catholic teachings on leadership, evangelization, and discipleship inspired by the life and witness of St. Francis of Assisi.*

In addition to this we have had several of our teens attend peer ministry training to assist adult catechists in our upcoming middle school sacrament prep classes and EDGE. Through all of these experiences, relationships with Christ have been formed, strengthened and it has overflowed with one another and into our families.

What is EDGE? EDGE is a *Catholic middle school (grades 6-8) youth ministry program. It provides a safe and fun place for youth to find solid Catholic community, to get answers to their questions about faith, and, most importantly, to experience Jesus in a profound and personal way. EDGE resources speak to the physical, psychological, cognitive, relational, and spiritual maturation of middle school youth. EDGE presents Catholic teaching in a way that young people can understand.* This program will begin in September.

It is our prayer that our youth will encounter God himself through our religious education, sacramental preparation, and youth ministry programs. *We are involved in this specific ministry not because of what we give to our young people, but because of what they have to give to the Church and the world when they open their hearts to God.*

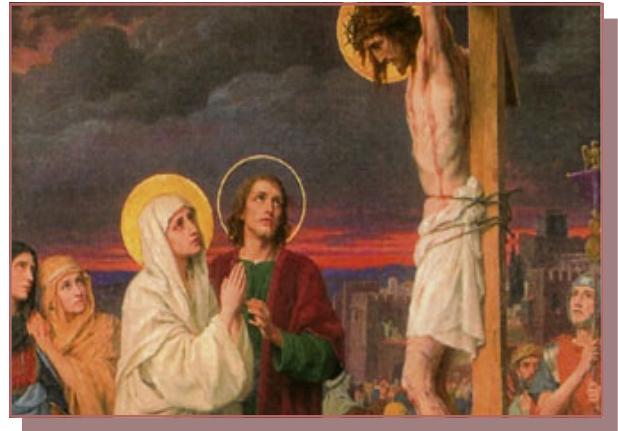

Qué verano tan ocupado ha sido para los que estamos involucrados en RCIT y Life Teen aquí en Cristo Rey. Quiero de antemano agradecer a todos nuestros compañeros de oración Envelop y a los Caballeros de Colón por su apoyo y oraciones. Sepan que también hemos estado orando por sus intenciones específicas. Es por sus oraciones y apoyo que pudimos arrancar el programa de verano con la noche de película, y el día de agua familiar aquí en las instalaciones, Noche de Sunsplash en Golfland, el Catholic Youth Congreso promovido por la Oficina de Liderazgo Hispano de la Diócesis, el Instituto de Verano de la Universidad de María, y por último la conferencia de Steubenville West en el campus de la Universidad de Arizona. Estuvimos presentes en esta conferencia con más de 2000 adolescentes, ministros de juventud, miembros del equipo, voluntarios y sacerdotes de varios otros estados. Uno de nuestros adolescentes también asistió a LEAD antes de Steubenville West. *El programa Franciscano LEAD es una inmersión de cinco días en enseñanzas Católicas de liderazgo, evangelización y discipulado impulsada por oración, empapada en sacramentos, llena de Cristo e inspirada por la vida y el testimonio de San Francisco de Asís.*

Además de esto, varios de nuestros adolescentes han asistido al entrenamiento de ministerio para mentores para ayudar a los catequistas adultos en nuestras próximas clases de preparación sacramental para alumnos de secundaria, así como en el programa EDGE. A través de todas estas experiencias, se han formado y fortalecido las relaciones de los miembros con Cristo, y esto se ha desbordado entre los miembros y hacia nuestras familias.

¿Qué es EDGE? EDGE es un *programa Católico de ministerio para jóvenes de secundaria (grados 6-8). Este programa provee un lugar seguro y divertido para los jóvenes para que puedan encontrar una comunidad Católica sólida, para encontrar respuestas a sus preguntas sobre la fe, y, más importante, para sentir a Jesús de una manera personal y profunda. Los recursos de EDGE se dirigen a la maduración física, fisiológica, cognitiva, relacional y espiritual de los jóvenes de secundaria. EDGE presenta enseñanzas Católicas de una manera en que los jóvenes pueden entender. Este programa comenzará en septiembre.*

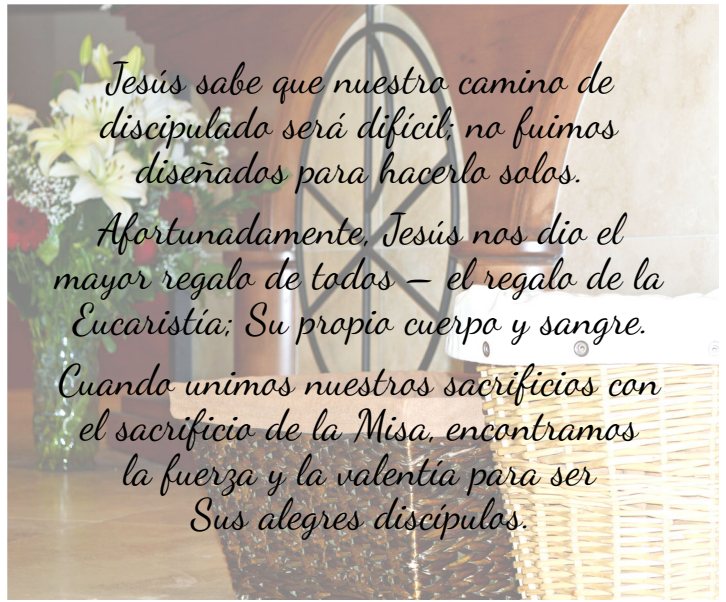

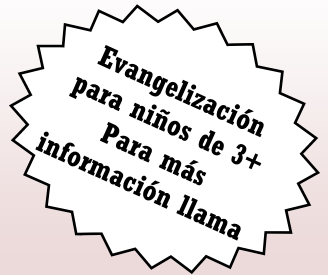

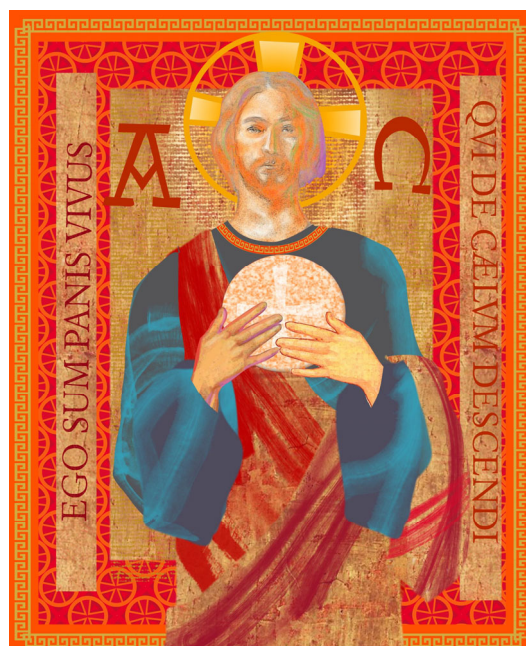
