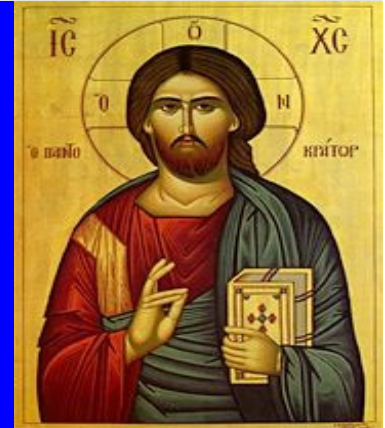

A Reverse Culture Shock Experience

Coming home isn't always easy. Besides traveling 23 hours, including lay-overs, I encountered, like any expatriate, some unexpected and daunting experiences. I encountered reverse culture shock.

Like culture shock, a reverse culture shock has a number of stages. Culture shock, according to Wikipedia, is an experience a person may have when one moves to a cultural environment which is different from one's own. It consists of four distinct phases, namely: honeymoon, negotiation, adjustment, and adaptation.

A reverse culture shock is like a U-shape curve. It was so exciting to return home: spending and conversing with family members, seeing friends, snuggle back into my bed, and eating my favorite local foods.

This initial euphoria eventually wears off. It's like so shocking to feel being out of place in my own culture. This is the experience of reverse culture shock. It's the bottom of the curve. Common problems like a slow internet, heavy traffic everywhere around Metro Manila, politics, which I feel I don't have right to say anything, reverse homesickness, feelings of alienation and misunderstood, among other things. There is a big contrast between the two cultures that has affected me personally.

The good news, however, is that after some days I gradually feel adjusted, comfortable and the vestiges of the "shock" slowly wear off. I experience the children's joy playing together, the family and friends' joviality, the gratitude of simple folks and their kindness on a daily basis.

What I constantly contend with now is a continual pull to go back. I feel the pull to return here, the place I call home. It is as if I am living in a kind of suspended reality, never really here and never really there; restless.

But, ultimately, what I have lost in hometown comfort, I have gained in my "other home" familiarity. Reconciling the two good experiences is a task to piece them all together into a patchwork quilt of sorts; to wear it day in and day out to bring me a kind of multicultural comfort of my own making.

FALL FIESTA

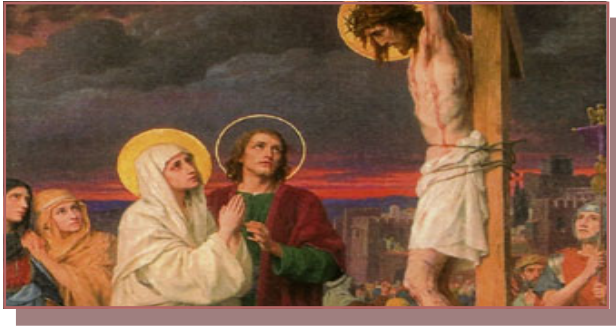

Una experiencia de choque cultural a la inversa

Regresar a casa no siempre es fácil. A demás de viajar 23 horas, incluyendo escalas, me encontré, como todo expatriado, algunas experiencias inesperadas y abrumantes. Me encontré con un choque cultural a la inversa.

Como el choque cultural, un choque cultural a la inversa tiene un número de etapas. El choque cultural, de acuerdo con Wikipedia, es una experiencia que puede tener una persona cuando se muda a un ambiente culturalmente diferente al suyo. Consiste en cuatro fases distintas, específicamente: luna de miel, negociación, ajuste y adaptación.

Un choque cultural a la inversa es como una curva en forma de U. Fue tan emocionante regresar a casa: pasar tiempo y conversar con mi familia, ver a mis amistades, acurrucarme de nuevo en mi cama, y disfrutar mis comidas locales favoritas.

Esta euforia inicial eventualmente se desvanece. Es tan impresionante sentirse fuera de lugar en mi propia cultura. Esta es la experiencia del choque cultural a la inversa. Es la baja de la curva; encontrarse con problemas comunes como un internet lento, mucho tráfico en Manila, sentir que no tengo derecho a poder opinar en cuestión de política, nostalgia inversa, sentimientos de alienación y malinterpretación, entre otras cosas. Hay un gran contraste entre las dos culturas que me ha afectado personalmente.

Independientemente, la buena noticia es que después de algunos días me siento gradualmente estable, a gusto, y los vestigios del “choque” van desvaneciendo poco a poco. Siento la alegría de los niños jugando, la jovialidad de la familia y los amigos, la gratitud de la gente sencilla y su amabilidad a diario.

Con lo que constantemente lucho ahora es un llamado continuo a regresar. Siento el llamado de regresar aquí, al lugar que llamo mi hogar. Es como si estuviera viviendo en un tipo de realidad suspendido, nunca realmente aquí ni realmente allá; inquieto.

Pero, en el fondo, lo que he perdido en consuelo de mi ciudad natal, he ganado en familiaridad en mi “otro hogar”. Es una gran tarea reconciliar las dos buenas experiencias en una sola, como en un tipo de edredón de retazos; usarlo día tras día me hace sentir un tipo de consuelo multicultural de mi propia creación.
