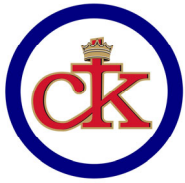

Christ the King Catholic School

Once again it is the time of year where the school crossing signs are back out and the back-to-school sales are in full-swing. Most of us can feel the gamut of emotions surrounding the start of a school year — today's children feel them too. Worried, excited, bored, sad, happy, anxious, curious, hopeful, fearful are all words that describe the feelings at this time. It is a great time for parents and their children to come together to celebrate another milestone and another year with a discussion around the dinner table about the upcoming school year and goals for faith life, learning, behavior, effort, and friends.

The teachers at Christ the King School have returned and are ready to begin the new school year. They are excited about their group of new students, new textbooks and resources. It is an exciting partnership that has made this happen, so successfully, so many times here at Christ the King.

This school year at Christ the King will begin with 241 students from 153 families and 27 staff members. The average number of students per class is 25 students (Pre K and 4th – 8th grade are not accepting new students at this time). Besides just the numbers, it is a community that we can all be proud of!

Last year the total scholarship and financial aid awarded was \$480,000 and it is anticipated that over \$850,000 will be available this year, including the Catholic Education Arizona tax credits that the parents and parishioners supported with such generosity. While there are parents that are still struggling to pay tuition, there are families who feel they cannot enroll their children because they do not think they cannot afford it. The good news is that there are still a few scholarships and spaces available.

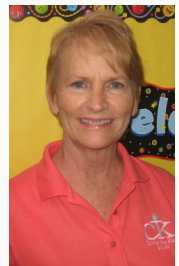

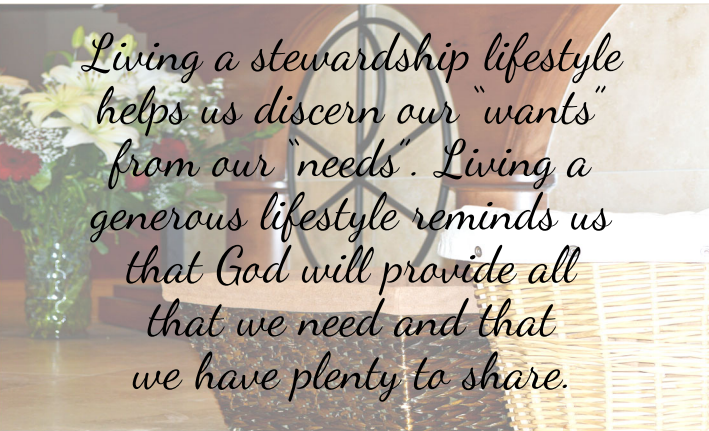

Thank you so much for hosting the blood drive on Sunday, July 22nd, and for arranging the use of St. Joseph Hall. It was so much nicer than a cramped bloodmobile at the far end of the parking lot on a hot day! Thank you to all who helped accommodate the blood drive. We appreciate your flexibility.

Ray, John, Tony and fellow Knights, thank *you* for your prep work to help ensure donors schedule appointments and/or walk-ins to help stabilize this week's blood supply. You are all amazing! Thank you for volunteering your time: Tony – thank you for calling past donors, my son also called through the official past donor list; Ray, thank you for meeting our collection team and helping ready the room; John, thank you for volunteering to meet and greet donors. Please let your brother Knights know how dear you all are to us.

The report has been released and official results are in. . .

Sunday: We had 26 successful donations: 19 whole blood, 6 power red and 1 plasma donations. The blood donated on July 22nd began helping approximately 99 hospital patients beginning on July 26th!

As you all can see, it truly takes a community to come together to save lives. Christ the King Catholic Parish is phenomenal!!!

Our next blood drive is Sunday, December 2nd. On behalf of the families whose loved ones will be receiving this precious life-saving medicine, *thank you* for caring!

Escuela Católica Cristo Rey

Una vez más llegó la época del año en que salen los letreros de cruce escolar y están en pleno apogeo las ventas de regreso a clases. La mayoría de nosotros puede sentir las emociones que rodean el comienzo del año escolar — los niños de hoy las sienten también. Preocupación, emoción, aburrimiento, tristeza, alegría, ansiedad, curiosidad, esperanza, temor, son todas palabras que describen los sentimientos a flote en esta época. Es una buena época para que padres e hijos se unan para celebrar otra meta y otro año con pláticas sobre la mesa acerca del nuevo año escolar y las metas de fe, aprendizaje, comportamiento, esfuerzo y amistades para la vida.

Los maestros de la Escuela Cristo Rey ya están de vuelta y listos para comenzar el nuevo año escolar. Están emocionados por recibir a sus nuevos de estudiantes, libros de texto y recursos. Es una colaboración emocionante que ha hecho esto posible, con tanto éxito tantas veces aquí en Cristo Rey.

Este año escolar en Cristo Rey comenzará con 241 estudiantes de 153 familias y 27 miembros del personal. El número promedio es de 25 estudiantes por clase (Pre K y 4to – 8vo grado ya no están aceptando nuevos estudiantes a esta altura). A parte de las cifras, ¡es una comunidad de la cual estamos muy orgullosos!

El año pasado el total en becas y asistencia financiera otorgados fue de \$480,000 y se anticipa que más de \$850,000 estará disponible este año, incluyendo los créditos de impuesto de la Educación Católica Arizona que los padres de familia y los feligreses aportaron con tanta generosidad. Mientras hay padres de familia que aún batallan para pagar colegiaturas, hay familias que sienten que no pueden inscribir a sus hijos porque piensan que no les alcanza para pagar la colegiatura. La buena noticia es que aún quedan unas cuantas becas y espacios disponibles.

En años anteriores, así como este año presente, algunos padres de familia de la Escuela Católica Cristo Rey, aquellos que han deseado las ventajas de una educación católica para sus hijos, han tenido que tomar un acto de fe para poder tomar la decisión de escoger una escuela Católica. Ya no necesita ser una decisión difícil -- la educación Católica está disponible, está al alcance del bolsillo ¡y está accesible para todos! Lo desapercibido, así como nos recuerda la Palabra de Dios, toma fe. Somos tan afortunados en la Escuela Cristo Rey de poder enseñar y aprender en un lugar donde...

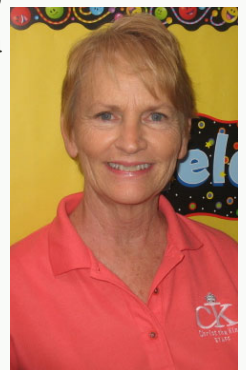

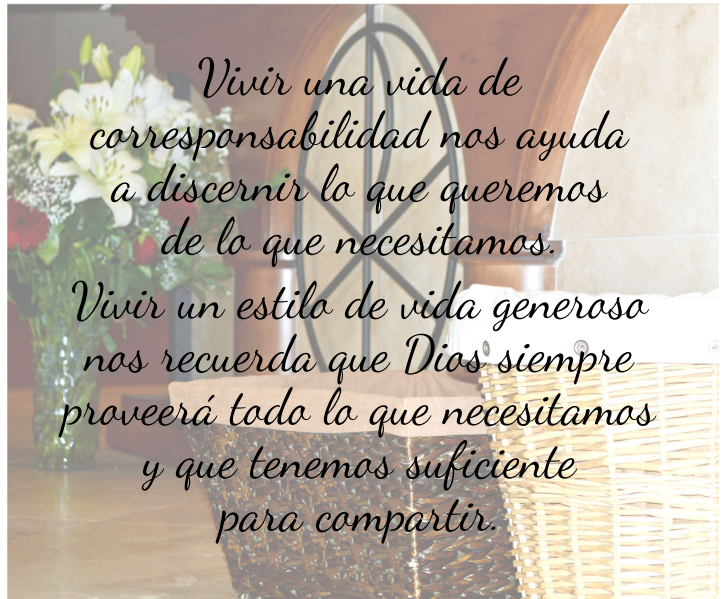

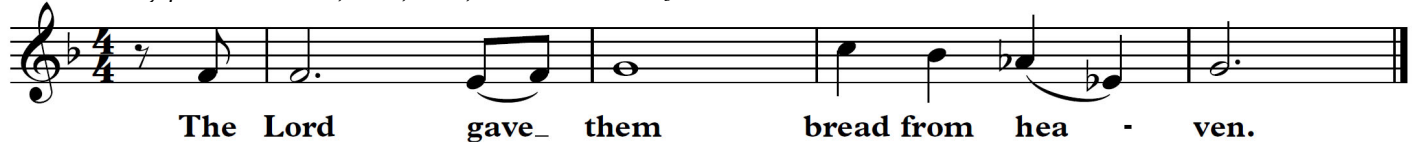
