Pilgrimage to the Holy Land: Walking in the Footsteps of Jesus

Going to the Holy Land, they say, would change the way you read the Bible. Because you actually see what the Bible is saying.

On April 23, 2013 to May 3, some 16 of us will be travelling to the Holy Land. One may loosely call it a vacation. But it is a pilgrimage. It is a journey, “Walking in the Footsteps of Jesus,” that is planned and scheduled by the Nativity Pilgrimage.

I accepted the invitation from the Nativity Pilgrimage organizers to lead the pilgrimage. I never thought, at first, that this pilgrimage would be a big gift to me on my 30th year sacerdotal anniversary. I had opportunities to visit the place before but other priorities like graduate studies and teaching took precedence.


Second, the opportunity has come to “put a face on the name.” Bethlehem is the birthplace of Jesus. Nazareth is where he grew up. And Jerusalem is where he preached, had his Last Supper with his disciples, where he was arrested, put into trial, condemned to death, crucified, and died. It is the “womb and tomb” of the Christian story. Jerusalem, then, is a place of deep sorrow, utter desolation but also of hope and redemption.

Third, it is a great opportunity to follow Jesus’ footsteps along the route that begins at the Lion’s Gate, passing through the fourteen stations of the cross, and ends at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, a place thought to be the site of Jesus’ crucifixion and his nearby tomb. This will surely be a life changing journey.

Hence, Jerusalem is more than just an historic place for us Christians. It is also a metaphor for all that we yearn for in this world and the next. It is a place, by the grace of God, we will one day attain after death. It also represents “a new heaven and a new earth” (Rev. 21: 1, NASB). While the real Jerusalem was where the drama of redemption took place, another “Jerusalem” might also be possible, something that we can build, as William Blake says in his poem “Jerusalem,” through Christ’s visit.

Throughout this journey, like a Good Shepherd, I am going to lead the pilgrims with the tour guide. I will celebrate masses to quench our spiritual thirst and hunger in different holy places. During those masses our intentions will be offered for you, the parishioners of Christ the King. I also ask you to pray for us.

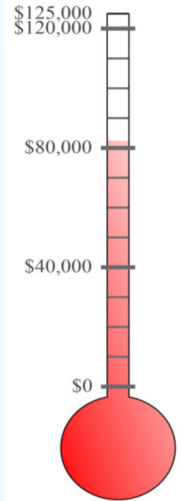

Charles Passe Scholarship for Post-High School Education

Charles Passe began his association with Christ the King Parish in 1981 after moving from Minnesota to Tucson, then to Mesa where he continued his love of woodworking.

Mr. Passe set up this endowment in 1994, and his commitment to young people and their success lives on through this endowed scholarship. Peregrinaje a Tierra Santa: Caminando por donde caminó Jesús

Ir a Tierra Santa, dicen, cambiaría la manera en que uno lee la Biblia, porque ahí se ve todo lo que la Biblia dice..

Del 23 de abril al 3 de mayo, dieciséis de nosotros viajaremos a Tierra Santa. Uno libremente podría llamarlo unas vacaciones. Pero es una peregrinación. “Caminando por donde caminó Jesús,” es un camino planeado y programado por Nativity Pilgrimage. Yo acepté la invitación de los organizadores de Nativity Pilgrimage para guiar el peregrinaje. Nunca pensé, al principio, que este peregrinaje sería un gran regalo para mí en mi aniversario de 30 años de sacerdocio. Tuve oportunidades para visitar el lugar antes, pero siempre tomaron precedencia otras prioridades como mis estudios superiores y la docencia.


Segundo, la oportunidad ha llegado de “poner un rostro al nombre.” Belén es el lugar de nacimiento de Jesús. Nazaret es donde creció. Y Jerusalén es donde predicó, tuvo su Última Cena con sus discípulos, donde fue arrestado, puesto en juicio, condenado a muerte, crucificado, y donde murió. Es el “vientre y la tumba” de la historia Cristiana. Jerusalén, entonces, es un lugar de gran tristeza y desolación inexpresable, pero también de esperanza y redención.

Tercero, es una gran oportunidad para seguir los pasos de Jesús por la ruta que comienza en la Puerta del León, pasando a través de catorce estaciones de la cruz, y termina en la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro, lugar que se piensa es el lugar de crucifixión de Jesús y su tumba cercana. Este seguramente será un viaje que cambiará mi vida.

Por tanto, Jerusalén es más que sólo un lugar histórico para nosotros los Cristianos. Es también una metáfora de todo lo que anhelamos en este mundo y el que sigue. Es un lugar que, por la gracia de Dios, un día obtendremos después de morir. También representa “un cielo nuevo y una tierra nueva” (Rev. 21: 1, Biblia de Jerusalén). Mientras la Jerusalén real fue donde ocurrió el drama de la redención, otra “Jerusalén” puede también ser posible, algo que podemos construir a través de la visita de Cristo, como dice William Blake en su poema “Jerusalén.”

En este camino, como Buen Pastor, guiaré a los peregrinos con el guía del tour. Celebraré Misas en distintos lugares sagrados para calmar nuestra sed y hambre espiritual. Durante esas misas ofreceremos nuestras intenciones por ustedes, los feligreses de Cristo Rey. También les pido oren por nosotros.
