When the Church cares for the sick, it serves Christ himself in the suffering members of his Mystical Body. *Sacred Congregation for Divine Worship, Prot. No. 1501/72*

“For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.” *Matthew 25:35-36*

“Throughout the centuries the Church has cared for the sick and provided spiritual nourishment for those who cannot attend Mass due to illness or confinement. Each day priests, religious and lay Pastoral Care Volunteers visit the sick and homebound as an extension of the sacramental life of the Parish, bringing Holy Communion and assuring them of constant prayers of the community.” *Thomas J. Olmsted, Bishop of Phoenix*

Here at Christ the King at the 9 am Sunday Mass, Father Rolyn commissioned ____ Pastoral Care Volunteers to participate with him in serving the mission of Christ, taking the Eucharist and the prayers of the community to our brothers and sisters who cannot come to Mass because of illness or being homebound. In addition to these volunteers, we have 10 volunteers who have been commissioned by Father to serve our Spanish speaking community.

On Thursday mornings, Pastoral Care Volunteers visit Allegiant, a nursing facility for the sick and group homes in our boundaries. The average visits made on Thursdays range from 20 to 30.

Please join me in thanking these volunteers for their generosity in helping us to serve our community! The Lord designed His Church that we, his faithful, could participate in His mission to go out and love one another. Thanks be to God!

Perhaps you may have experienced a tug on your heart to visit the sick, to inquire about the Pastoral Care Ministry. Would you consider being a part of this ministry? Give me a call and we can talk about the many ways that you can share in this ministry. There are many needs from clerical to actually going out to visit the sick.
