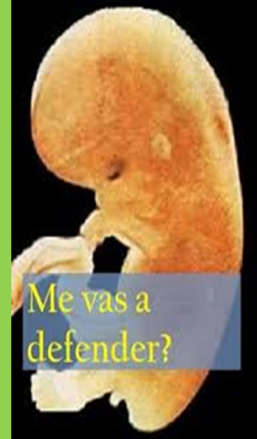

O GOD BEYOND ALL PRAISING

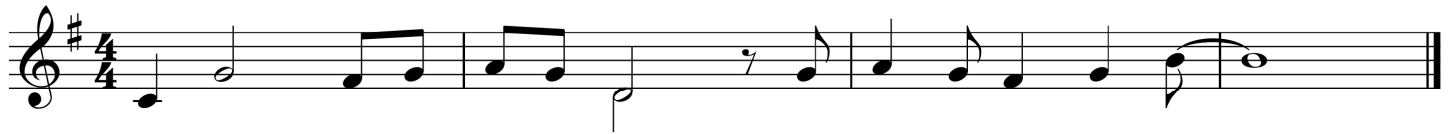
