### **Forming Families for Discipleship:**

This past summer as many changes came about in the religious education staff and program, one of the first topics we discussed was evangelizing not only the student, but the family as a whole. We understand the importance of forming young people as disciples of Christ, yet how much greater would it be to have families being strengthened as the primary evangelists and catechists through intentional, Christ centered relationships.

### **Involving Families in Catechesis: The family is central to our Catholic faith:**

As much as we would like to receive credit, this is not a new idea since, the catechism, states, the Church sees “the family as the first natural society.” (p211) In fact, the theme of “family” is found throughout Sacred Scripture as, “God reveals himself as a “family” — Father, Son and Holy Spirit — a communion of persons. God created us, male and female, in His image and likeness (Gn 1:26-27; CCC p2205). We are created to be in communion with one another. Jesus reveals God as a Father who loves and cares for his children. The Church is revealed to us as a family into which we are adopted by God and become brothers and sisters to one another (Gal 4:4-5). Jesus’ relationship with the Church is presented in Scripture as a marriage, with Jesus as the groom and the Church His Bride.

### **Family-Adult Formation:**

The family has a privileged place in catechesis. The Catechism states that “parents receive the responsibility of evangelizing their children” and calls them the “First heralds” of the faith (p2225). The family is called “domestic church” — the church of the home. Yet, we the religious education staff understand many of the challenges our families are facing and want to assist families.

In addition, to our regular religious education classes, sacrament prep classes, EDGE and Life Teen Youth Ministries, we are currently offering classes to parents and caregivers twice a week in both English and Spanish at no cost to the family. Already we are hearing about the healing that is taking place within our families through these classes.

Pope John Paul II famously said, “As the family goes, so goes society, and so goes the world in which we live.” We could just as easily say, “As the family goes, so goes the parish, and so goes the Church in which we live,” for our parishes are made up of families, and every child with a vocation to the priesthood and religious life is born within a family. For this reason, Pope Benedict has said, “The family...is the cradle of life and of every vocation” (Angelus talk, Feb. 4, 2007). Let us renew our commitment to place families at the center of our catechetical efforts.

### **Formando a las familias para el discipulado:**

Este pasado verano, mientras vimos muchos cambios en el programa y el personal de catecismo, uno de los primeros temas que tocamos fue la evangelización no sólo de los estudiantes, sino de la familia entera. Entendemos la importancia de formar a los jóvenes como discípulos de Cristo, pero cuánto más increíble sería fortalecer a las familias a través de relaciones intencionales y centradas en Cristo, siendo ellas los principales evangelizadores y catequistas.

### **Involucrando a las familias en Catecismo: La familia es central en nuestra fe católica:**

Nos encantaría recibir el mérito, pero ésta no es una idea nueva, ya que el Catecismo indica que la Iglesia ve a “la familia como la primera sociedad natural.” (p211) De hecho, el tema de “familia” se encuentra a lo largo de las Sagradas Escrituras, pues, “Dios se revela Él mismo como una “familia” — Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo — una comunión de personas. Dios nos creó, hombre y mujer, en Su imagen (Gen 1:26-27; CCC p2205). Fuimos creados para estar en comunión unos con otros. Jesús revela a Dios como un Padre que ama y se preocupa por sus hijos. Se nos revela que la Iglesia es la familia en la cual somos adoptados por Dios y todos nos convertimos en hermanos y hermanas (Gal 4:4-5). La relación de Jesús con la Iglesia es presentada en las Escrituras como un matrimonio, con Jesús como el novio y la Iglesia su novia.

### **Formación para familias y adultos:**

La familia tiene un lugar privilegiado en la catequesis. El Catecismo indica que “los padres reciben la responsabilidad de evangelizar a sus hijos” y los llama los “primeros heraldos” de la fe (p2225). La familia es referida como “la iglesia doméstica” — la iglesia del hogar. Aún así, nosotros, el personal de catecismo entendemos muchos de los retos que las familias enfrentan y queremos ayudar a las familias. Adicionalmente, actualmente estamos ofreciendo clases a los padres y tutores de nuestras clases de catecismo y preparación sacramental, y los ministerios de jóvenes EDGE y Life Teen, dos veces a la semana en inglés y en español sin costo para la familia. Ya hemos estado escuchando de la sanación que está ocurriendo dentro de las familias a través de estas clases.

Es bien sabido que San Juan Pablo II dijo: “Como anda la familia, así anda la sociedad, y el mundo en el que vivimos.” Podríamos también fácilmente decir: “Como anda la familia, así anda la parroquia, y la Iglesia en que vivimos,” pues nuestras parroquias están formadas de familias, y cada persona con vocación para el sacerdocio y la vida religiosa nace dentro de una familia. Por esta razón, el Papa Benedicto ha dicho: “La familia...es la cuna de la vida y de cada vocación” (Angelus talk, Feb. 4, 2007). Renovemos nuestro compromiso de colocar a las familias en el centro de nuestros esfuerzos catequéticos.




