St. Peregrine Cancer Shrine

The mission of the St. Peregrine Cancer Shrine is to promote perpetual adoration of Jesus Christ and to pray for those affected by cancer.

The St. Peregrine Cancer Shrine celebrates its ninth year! In November of 2009, the doors were opened to the Perpetual Adoration Chapel. The mission was written and the journey began. It was in obedience to the mission in promoting adoration of our Lord Jesus Christ that the mission to pray for those affected by cancer began to take form. The ministries that surfaced were ones that shared the gift of prayer and supported the mission of the Shrine.

The St. Peregrine Cancer Ministries are the Prayer Shawl Ministry, the Cancer Ministry, the Monument Ministry (in the process of being developed) and the Shipping Center. As the ministry continues to grow, new branches are formed that support the work of the mission.

In 2011, the Prayer Shawl Ministry gave 110 shawls out. This year, 452 shawls were shipped across the world. The cancer ministry began taking prayer requests and placing them on a small round item table, with 17 requests in 2011. As of today, we have answered 4,486 prayer requests and shipped 2,574 prayer shawls. We could not have done this without you, the many who have responded with a gift of time, prayer and financial support.

People write in to share how these precious gifts have affected their journey. I have shared one with you:

“It was in late April, my daughter visited the Shrine and had my son’s name placed on the prayer wall. We were amazed at how many cards of love, prayer and encouragement he was receiving. Those cards always brought tears to my eyes just seeing how giving these people were to someone they did not know...” So blessed to have the Shrine in the southwest!

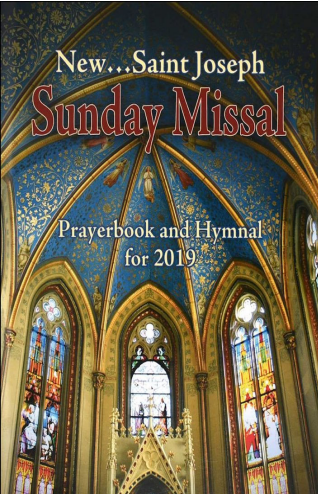

La misión del Santuario de Cáncer San Peregrino es promover la adoración perpetua de Jesucristo y orar por aquellos que están afectados por el cáncer.

¡El Santuario de Cáncer San Peregrino celebra su noveno año! En noviembre de 2009, se abrieron las puertas a la capilla de adoración perpetua. Se escribió la misión y comenzó la jornada. Fue en obediencia a la misión de promover adoración de nuestro Señor Jesucristo que la misión de orar por aquellos que están afectados por el cáncer comenzó a tomar forma. Los ministerios que surgieron fueron ministerios que se dedican a compartir el don de la oración en apoyo al Santuario.

Los ministerios del Santuario de Cáncer San Peregrino son: el Ministerio de chales de oración, el Ministerio de cáncer, el Ministerio del monumento (actualmente en desarrollo) y el Centro de envíos. Al ir creciendo el ministerio, nuevas ramas se van formando en apoyo al trabajo de la misión.

En 2011, el ministerio de chales de oración envió 110 chales. Éste año se enviaron 452 chales alrededor del mundo. El ministerio de cáncer comenzó a aceptar pedidos de oración y colocándolos en una mesa pequeña, con 17 pedidos en 2011. A fecha de hoy hemos respondido a 4,486 pedidos de oración y enviado 2,574 chales de oración. Esto no se podría haber logrado sin el apoyo de tantas personas que han respondido con el regalo de su tiempo, oración y apoyo financiero.
