## **“Impact Culture for Christ”**

As a Bible Theology student I was blessed to attend John Paul the Great Catholic University. The school is also a Catholic University for Creative Arts and Business Innovation who desires to “shape leaders and creators for the 21st century with artistic excellence, building up an authentic Catholic community, while fostering an encounter with the transforming love and truth of Jesus Christ.” It is an institution with the mission statement deriving from the Gospel of Luke 5:4 that says, “Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch.” This is not a plug for the school, yet speaks of Pope Paul VI’s message on evangelization in the modern world.

The USCCB states “We can rephrase his words to say that evangelizing means bringing the Good News of Jesus into every human situation and seeking to convert individuals and society by the divine power of the Gospel itself.”

So how do we connect religious education, catechetical formation, and sacramental preparation with the call to mission in the world as Christ's disciples? How do we reach our youth that live in an entertainment saturated, distracting and noisy world? The answer is connecting on a human level. We do this by reminding our young people of their humanity and by answering the questions that speak to their every day lives. After all, isn't this what Jesus did?

Religious education is so much more than attending classes once a week, it's what St. Thomas Aquinas defines as “the striving of the spirit toward great things” and an opportunity for “man to acknowledge his status as a creature of God.” This type of education has eternal value, it invites us to focus on great things. Religious education teaches us to be confident in our identity in Christ, our need and fidelity to the Church, and the need for one another.

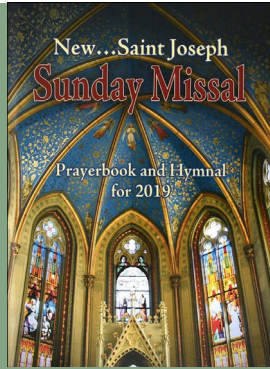

## “Cultura de impacto para Cristo”

Como estudiante de Teología de las Sagradas Escrituras, tuve la bendición de asistir a la Universidad Católica Juan Pablo el Grande. La educación religiosa nos enseña a tener confianza en nuestra identidad en Cristo, nuestra necesidad y fidelidad a la Iglesia, y la necesidad que tenemos unos de otros.

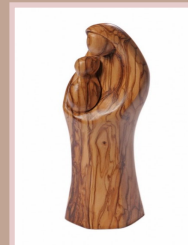
