Jesus is Born!

The good news came first to shepherds. They were in the fields and slept side by side with their sheep, carrying the smell of the animals with them always. They would have been less than welcomed in the malls and churches with their dirt and smell and matted hair. Yet it is these people, living on the margins, who first hear of the birth of the Savior. Not only were the terrified shepherds reassured, “Be not afraid,” but they were invited to seek out the baby and to be the first to meet this Savior face to face.

The people in Jesus’ time, and in our own, faced wars and were led by inadequate leaders, both religious and secular, who brought unnecessary suffering and eventual destruction of the nation. The people wondered if they would ever be safe. Yet, the “child is born”, and the “people who walked in darkness have seen a great light...” and for “those who lived in a land of gloom a light has shone” (Is. 9). The yoke that burdened them was broken and brought them abundant joy.

Let us remember that Jesus is with each of us as He was with the shepherds, whispering “a light has shone.” We may be covered with dirt and smell due to sins but, like the shepherds, we are being called to meet our Savior and to rejoice.

It is my prayer that, as we celebrate Christmas, we will find joy and true peace and that the Light shine into our lives.

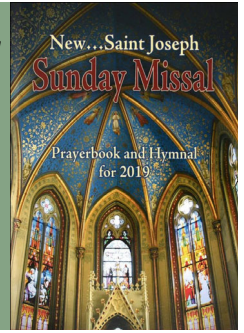

La gente de la época de Jesús, así como la gente de nuestra época, se enfrentaban con guerras y tenían líderes religiosos y seculares ineptos, que traían sufrimiento innecesario y eventualmente la destrucción de la nación. La gente se preguntaba si alguna vez estarían a salvo. Sin embargo, el “niño es nacido”, y “el pueblo que andaba a oscuras vio una luz grande...” y para “los que vivían en tierra de sombras, una luz brilló sobre ellos” (Is. 9). El yugo que cargaban fue roto y eso les llenó de abundante alegría.

Recordemos que Jesús está con cada uno de nosotros como estaba con los pastores, susurrando “una luz ha brillado.” Estaremos cubiertos de polvo y olor por nuestros pecados, pero, como los pastores, estamos siendo llamados a conocer a nuestro Señor y a llenarnos de alegría.

Es mi oración que, al celebrar la Navidad, encontremos alegría y verdadera paz y que la Luz brille en nuestras vidas.

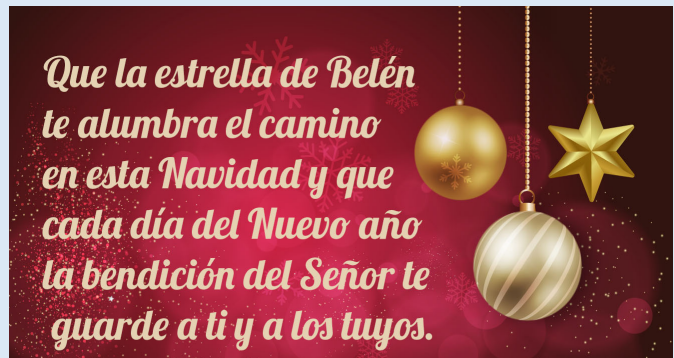
