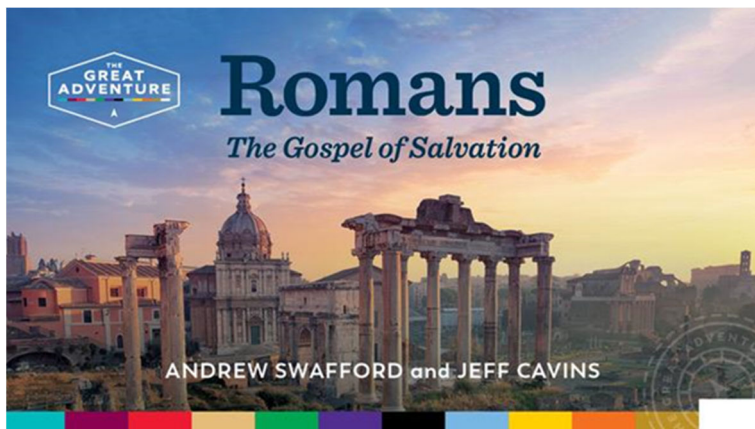

Requisitos para los padres: (Es necesario que los padres asistan a dos clases)

- La primera clase es sólo para los padres. Los padrinos no necesitan asistir a esta clase.
- En la segunda clase los padres y los padrinos necesitan estar presente.
- No se permiten niños en estas dos clases.
- Las clases comienzan en punto. Si llega tarde tendrá que asistir a otra clase.
- Padres, por favor no escojan sus padrinos hasta que asistan a la primera clase para recibir la información necesaria.

Por favor traiga el certificado de nacimiento del niño a la segunda clase.

Requisitos para los padrinos:

- Necesitan ser Católicos
- Han recibido los sacramentos de bautismo, confirmación y primera comunión.

- Si escoje dos padrinos, tienen que ser un hombre y una mujer.
- Los padrinos tienen que tener a lo menos, 16 años.
- Los padrinos tienen que estar presentes en la segunda clase con los padres del niño.
- Es necesario que los padres y padrinos firmen un juramento, que los padrinos tienen todos los requisitos que la iglesia Católica pide para que sean padrinos.

Los padrinos deben traer copias de los siguientes certificados:

- Confirmación
- Si es casado, Sacramento del Matrimonio

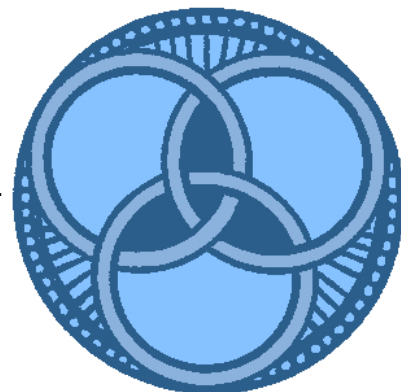

Zechariah wanted a son, to raise, to guide, to behold. He couldn't believe the gift he'd receive, so in silence he did as he was told.

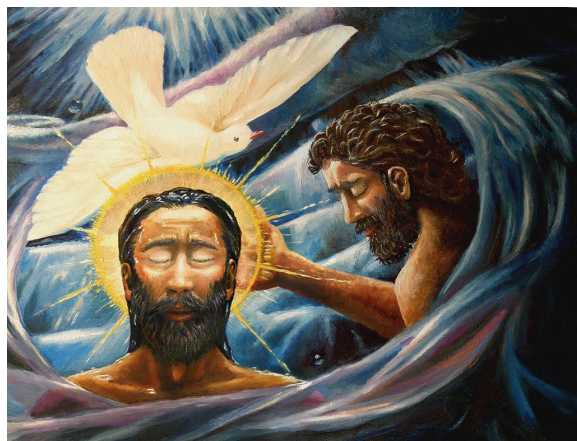
John danced in the womb, for his cousin, his savior, the Lord. By grace he was given the Spirit so he could baptize the Word.
