“Be Perfect as Your Heavenly Father is Perfect”

Today’s readings prepare us for the season of Lent. Our Lord Jesus gives us the command, saying: “Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you. The heavenly Father loves and rewards both the bad and the good, the just and the unjust. Be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect” (Mt. 5: 38-48).

However, they seem like absurd commands. We may find ourselves reacting, saying: “And who has the right to ask me for an extra shirt, much less a coat? I reluctantly give up a minute of service, much less a mile. Go two miles? Love enemies? It’s hard to love those close at hand. Who will likely carry them out?

Literally, the word “perfect” that is used here means “complete.” The heavenly Father is perfectly complete! Each of us is called to be a reflection of the character of God. That’s what it means to be created in the image of God. Paul in his second letter to the Corinthians (2 Cor. 5: 20 – 6: 2) tells us that God gives us enough grace to overcome sin. Theoretically, we can be perfect though none of us is. Sin, in the Christian life, is inevitable because of our weakness. And there are multitude of opportunities we have to sin that the Lord keeps calling us back to Him with our whole heart, with fasting, weeping, and mourning (Jl 2: 12-18).

This coming Wednesday is 'Ash Wednesday.' We will begin our Lenten pilgrimage. Lent is a Holy Season, a time of grace, a period comprising forty days during which the whole Church renews itself through prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

As we begin our spiritual journey this Lent, let us go after Real Love, the kind Jesus describes and which God makes possible in us. And I would like to end my message with the story about kids playing on a snowy field. It was winter and it had snowed heavily. A group of children were trying to see who could make the straightest track across a snowy field. Only one of them succeeded in making a path which was almost perfectly straight. When asked how he managed to do it, he said, “It was easy. I just kept my eyes fixed on the lightning rod (‘Real Love’) on top of the barn at the end of the field – while the rest of you kept looking at your feet.”

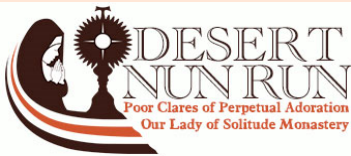

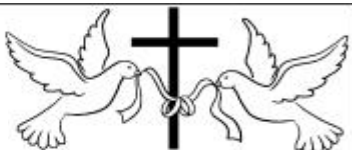

"Sé perfecto como tu Padre Celestial es perfecto"

Las lecturas de hoy nos preparan para la temporada de Cuaresma. Nuestro Señor Jesús nos da la orden, diciendo: "Ama a tus enemigos y reza por los que te persiguen. El Padre celestial ama y recompensa tanto lo malo como lo bueno, lo justo y lo injusto. Sé perfecto, como tu Padre celestial es perfecto" (Mt. 5: 38-48).

Sin embargo, parecen comandos absurdos. Podemos encontrarnos reaccionando, diciendo: "¿Y quién tiene derecho a pedirme una camisa extra, y mucho menos un abrigo? De mala gana renuncio a un minuto de servicio, mucho menos a una milla. ¿Ir dos millas? ¿Amar a los enemigos? Es difícil amar a los que están cerca. ¿Quién probablemente los llevará a cabo?"

Literalmente, la palabra "perfecto" que se usa aquí significa "completo". ¡El Padre celestial está perfectamente completo! Cada uno de nosotros está llamado a ser un reflejo del carácter de Dios. Eso es lo que significa ser creado a imagen de Dios. Pablo en su segunda carta a los Corintios (2 Cor. 5: 20 - 6: 2) nos dice que Dios nos da la gracia suficiente para vencer el pecado. Teóricamente, podemos ser perfectos aunque ninguno de nosotros lo sea. El pecado, en la vida cristiana, es inevitable debido a nuestra debilidad. Y hay muchas oportunidades que tenemos para pecar que el Señor sigue llamándonos de regreso a Él con todo nuestro corazón, con ayuno, llanto y luto (Jl 2: 12-18).

El próximo miércoles es 'Miércoles de ceniza'. Comenzaremos nuestra peregrinación cuaresmal. La Cuaresma es una temporada santa, un tiempo de gracia, un período que comprende cuarenta días durante los cuales toda la Iglesia se renueva a través de la oración, el ayuno y la limosna.

Al comenzar nuestro viaje espiritual en esta Cuaresma, sigamos el Amor Real, del tipo que Jesús describe y que Dios hace posible en nosotros. Y me gustaría terminar mi mensaje con la historia de niños jugando en un campo nevado. Era invierno y había nevado mucho. Un grupo de niños intentaba ver quién podía hacer el camino más recto a través de un campo nevado. Solo uno de ellos logró hacer un camino que era casi perfectamente recto. Cuando se le preguntó cómo logró hacerlo, dijo: "Fue fácil. Solo mantuve mis ojos fijos en el pararrayos ("Amor Real") en la parte superior del granero al final del campo, mientras que el resto de ustedes seguían mirando sus pies".

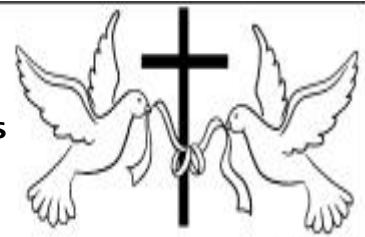
