As baptized members of the Church, youth are called to serve others and to serve Christ, bringing about the Kingdom of God in unique ways. At Christ the King Catholic School we strive to support parents by offering students service opportunities that empower children and adolescents to choose Christian lives of discipleship.

Catholic School is a living faith community where students can deepen their understanding of the Catholic faith both inside and outside of the classroom. A Catholic education strengthens the connection for a child to the gifts and talents for the wider Church community. CTK teachers offer service projects, retreats and effective religious education.

Student service spans the entire year with participation in the annual Coat Drive, Blanket Drive, Food and Supply Drives for HOPE. The students attend field trips to “Feed our Starving Children” and others to the Cathedral for the Catholic Schools Week. All classes adopt a Seminarian and write letters multiple times during the year. The Second Grade class leads the “Birthday Card” outreach to our parishioners while Kindergarten students draw pictures and write to those who journey with a cancer diagnosis. Students and teachers attend Mass and spend time in prayer and Adoration in the St. Peregrine Cancer Shrine.



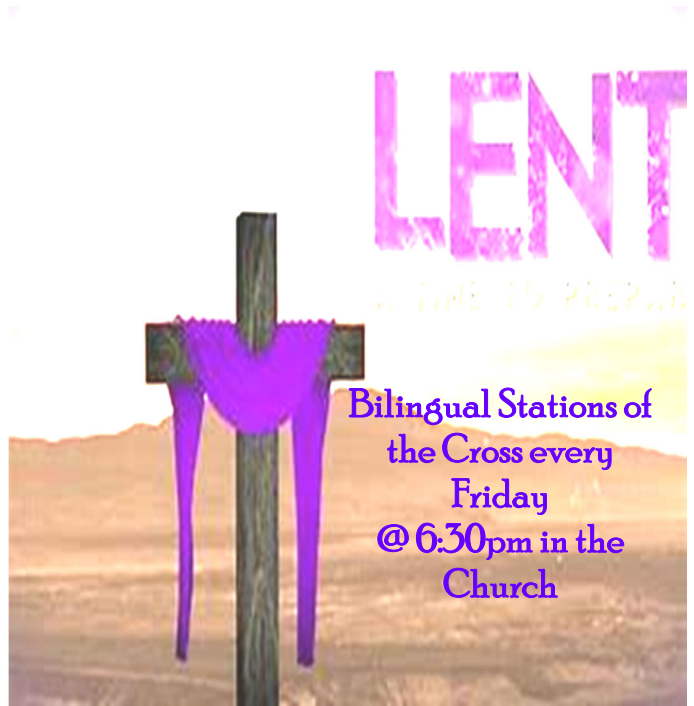

Students volunteer in Special Olympics, at HOPE, as Guide Dog trainers, as Altar Servers and other places within the community, the Parish and the School. Lenten Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own *sui iuris* Church.

En la escuela católica Cristo Rey nos esforzamos por apoyar a los padres al ofrecerles a los estudiantes oportunidades de servicio que capacitan a los niños y adolescentes para elegir vidas cristianas de discipulado.

Catholic School es una comunidad de fe viva donde los estudiantes pueden profundizar su comprensión de la fe católica tanto dentro como fuera del aula. La clase de Segundo grado dirige el alcance de la “Tarjeta de cumpleaños” a nuestros feligreses, mientras que los estudiantes de kindergarten dibujan y escriben a aquellos con un diagnóstico de cáncer. Estudiantes y maestros asisten a misa y pasan tiempo en oración y adoración en el Santuario del Cáncer de San Peregrino.



Cada año, tenemos un número de alumnos de octavo grado como receptores de los premios de Servicio Cristiano debido a sus cientos de horas de servicio. Los estudiantes son voluntarios en Olimpiadas Especiales, en HOPE, como entrenadores de perros guía, como Servidores de Altar y otros lugares dentro de la comunidad, la Parroquia y la Escuela. Nos sentimos honrados por las buenas obras que demuestran los estudiantes.

Nos esforzamos por crear un entorno para ayudar a nuestros estudiantes a aprender sobre la limosna no sólo durante la cuaresma sino durante todo el año en Cristo Rey. Estamos agradecidos de tener la oportunidad de trabajar con usted para hacer de este viaje cuaresmal una tradición durante todo el año.

Ayuno Cuaresmal y Abstinencia

El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días obligatorios de ayuno y abstinencias para los católicos. Además, los Viernes durante la Cuaresma son días obligatorios de abstinencia. Para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Latina, las normas sobre el ayuno son obligatorias desde los 18 años hasta los 59 años. Al ayunar, a una persona se le permite comer una comida completa, así como dos comidas más pequeñas que juntas no son iguales a una comida completa. Las normas relativas a la abstinencia de carne son vinculantes para los miembros de la Iglesia Católica Latina desde los 14 años en adelante. Si es posible, el ayuno del Viernes Santo se continúa hasta la Vigilia Pascual (en la noche del Sábado Santo) como el “ayuno pascual” para honrar el sufrimiento y la muerte del Señor Jesús, y para prepararnos para compartir más plenamente y celebrar más fácilmente su resurrección los miembros de las Iglesias católicas orientales deben observar la ley particular de su propia Iglesia sui iuris,
