## The Walk to H.O.P.E.



The name of our food pantry stands for “HELPING OTHER PEOPLE EMERGE”. Most often, we think of our very generous parishioners and the food boxes and resource information that we are able to provide to our clients on a regular basis. (On average, H.O.P.E. lends a helping hand to 89 households each week, with more families being served during the holidays.) Less often, we realize that those of us who contribute and serve are equally the recipients of God’s gracious help in giving our lives greater purpose. Lent is the perfect time to reflect on almsgiving!

Just a few weeks ago, the entire student body of Christ the King Catholic School participated in a walk from the school to the Community Center where H.O.P.E. is located. It was so exciting to hear the children’s voices as they neared the center, and so impressive to see the children, parents, and teachers walk into the parking lot with wagons and bags filled with food and personal hygiene items. As they entered the building, each classroom brought forth their gifts and placed them in milk crates that were set out waiting to collect them. When all of the children, parents, and school staff were assembled, H.O.P.E. volunteers demonstrated what we do and how important H.O.P.E. is in the lives of our clients. They talked about the differences the students were making with the food, coat, blanket, and school-supply drives they participate in during the school year, and how thankful we are for their service to those in need. The children listened quietly to stories describing some of the clients’ difficulties. At the end of the demonstration and presentation, the children reflected their kind and generous natures in the concerned questions they asked. Those older students who have helped at H.O.P.E. on Thursday evenings were asked to stand and be recognized. What a wonderful opportunity for all of the students to serve the needs of our clients in bringing their gifts, but also to learn how important service is in their lives and to the population that needs them.

Feeding the hungry – “giving alms to the poor” – is one of the Works of Mercy which is especially important to H.O.P.E. Many of you contribute to H.O.P.E. all year long, and in doing so you perform countless acts of Mercy. We are so grateful for your support. During this season of Lent, H.O.P.E. would like to encourage one and all to participate in providing food for the hungry within our parish boundaries. Please, join the children in giving alms to the poor.

( En promedio, HOPE Brinda una mano amiga a 89 hogares cada semana, con más familias atendidas durante las vacaciones). Con menos frecuencia, nos damos cuenta de que aquellos de nosotros que contribuimos y servimos somos igualmente receptores de la amable ayuda de Dios para nuestras vidas. Mayor propósito ¡La Cuaresma es el momento perfecto para reflexionar sobre la limosna!
