A MESSAGE FOR YOU

We observe why does God allow sinners to prosper, while the good and faithful followers suffer? Today's readings provide us some answers. The Book of Wisdom says that God cares for all people, believers or non-believers. To all people God shows righteousness and he is willing to look for ways to spare all people. God is patient with those who have doubts, and shows impatience to those who are insolent, who do not respect others who may not yet know God.

Jesus' answer to the problem of evil tells us that God wishes to allow the sinners time for repentance and further growth. The weeds grow up in the field along with the grain. But justice demands a sorting. God is indeed just. Hopefully though, that justice will be tempered with mercy and only at the very end will there be judgment. Until then there is forgiveness, and those who have remained righteous will be highly rewarded. All three parables show this concept of mixing – good seed and weed seed, yeast and unleavened bread, small seed and large tree. All of us have a chance to be saved, and so we need to respect all people and their potential, and let the judging come from the merciful One. Our own judgments are sometimes not so merciful!

We need to simply remember that to be like God, we need to be kind, compassionate, accepting, loving and non-judgmental. I am not sure those are all easy qualities to have, but that is what is being asked of us today. The more we strive to be like God in those areas, the more chance we have that we will not be seen to be the weeds at the very end.

Lest we forget also that the garden upon which the weeds and seeds grow together is our very own life. God steadily forgives our faults, the weeds, and lets us develop and grow without uprooting us. It is not that he wants to encourage the weeds, our faults—it would be better if they were not there. But he is careful not to pull out our life along with our faults.

Let us try this week to put into practice these virtues, make one specific attempt to show mercy to someone, to show love to someone, to accept someone, to be kind to someone. Besides, it might bring to each of us a little happiness as well, and we can all use lots of that!



Are You in Need of Financial Assistance?

Do you reside in the city of Phoenix? Have you or someone you know been financially impacted by COVID-19? Are you struggling to keep up with your monthly payments?

Phoenix COVID 19 program offers financial relief to help you pay your utility bills (electric, gas and water bill), rent and mortgage payment!

How Do I Qualify?

Households must be city of Phoenix residents and financially impacted by COVID-19 national pandemic. Only charges incurred after March 1, 2020 are eligible for payment.

How Much Can I Receive?

- Utility bills (electric and gas) \$600
- City of Phoenix water bills \$300
- Rent or Mortgage payments \$1,100
- Households in subsidized housing must have a rental obligation to qualify for rental assistance.

What Documentation Will I Need?

Job/Wage Instability Proof

- Termination letter from employer
- Proof of unemployment application
- Proof client has applied for benefits

Impact to household income

- Documentation proving hours/wages reduction from employer
- Documentation stating an increase in child care or adult care expenses

City of Phoenix Residency Verification Documents

- Drivers license, work or school ID, public benefit award letter (i.e., SNAP or TANF), utility bill, mortgage bill, or leasing agreement

MENSAJE PARA USTED

Observamos por qué Dios permite que los pecadores prosperen, mientras que los seguidores buenos y fieles sufren. Las lecturas de hoy nos brindan algunas respuestas. El Libro de la Sabiduría dice que Dios se preocupa por todas las personas, creyentes o no creyentes. Para todas las personas, Dios muestra justicia y está dispuesto a buscar formas de perdonar a todas las personas. Dios es paciente con aquellos que tienen dudas, y muestra impaciencia hacia aquellos que son insolentes, que no respetan a otros que aún no conocen a Dios.

La respuesta de Jesús al problema del mal nos dice que Dios desea permitirles a los pecadores tiempo para el arrepentimiento y un mayor crecimiento. Las malas hierbas crecen en el campo junto con el grano. Pero la justicia exige una clasificación. Dios es de hecho justo. Sin embargo, es de esperar que la justicia se modere con misericordia y solo al final habrá juicio. Hasta entonces hay perdón, y aquellos que han permanecido justos serán altamente recompensados. Las tres parábolas muestran este concepto de mezcla: buenas semillas y semillas de malezas, levadura y pan sin levadura, semillas pequeñas y árboles grandes. Todos tenemos la oportunidad de ser salvos, por lo que debemos respetar a todas las personas y su potencial, y dejar que el juicio venga del Misericordioso.

¡Nuestros propios juicios a veces no son tan misericordiosos!

Simplemente debemos recordar que para ser como Dios, debemos ser amables, compasivos, receptivos, amorosos y sin prejuicios. No estoy seguro de que sean cualidades fáciles de tener, pero eso es lo que se nos pide hoy. Cuanto más nos esforzamos por ser como Dios en esas áreas, más posibilidades tenemos que no seremos vistos como las malas hierbas al final.

Para que no olvidemos también que el jardín en el que crecen juntas las malas hierbas y las semillas es nuestra propia vida. Dios perdona constantemente nuestros defectos, las malas hierbas, y nos permite desarrollarnos y crecer sin desarraigarnos. No es que quiera alentar las malas hierbas, nuestros defectos, sería mejor si no estuvieran allí. Pero él tiene cuidado de no sacar nuestra vida junto con nuestros defectos

Intentemos esta semana poner en práctica estas virtudes, hacer un intento específico de mostrar misericordia a alguien, mostrar amor a alguien, aceptar a alguien, ser amable con alguien. Además, podría traer a cada uno de nosotros un poco de felicidad también, ¡y todos podemos usar mucho de eso!
